

2012 Shakopee School Football Registration Information – Grades 9-12

Process

- 🐾 Cost is \$120 per participant. All fees & limits are subject to change.*
- 🐾 Registration begins mid-June (*see Important Dates section below*). Paperwork needs to be turned in prior to the start of the season (mid-August, see below).**
- 🐾 All required paperwork can be obtained by following the links below or by stopping by the High School, Junior High or Middle School main office lobbies between 8:00 AM and 3:30 PM.
- 🐾 Paperwork needs to be turned in to the High School Activities Office anytime during normal business hours (7:30 AM to 4:00 PM) beginning on the Registration Start date below (mid-June).
- 🐾 A parent/athlete Information Meeting will be held for football grades 9-12 in the Student Commons area at the High School, usually in early-August (see Important Dates section below). All parent/athletes are expected to attend to make sure you have all the necessary information to begin the season.
- 🐾 The season's official start date is listed below. Mark your calendars and plan your vacations wisely!!!

Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) Eligibility	This form is updated each summer and is located at http://www.rschooldtoday.com/se3bin/clientgenie.cgi
Info Release, Permission and Acknowledgement (done annually)	Included in Eligibility Packet above.
Emergency Medical Information (done each sport season)	Included in Eligibility Packet above.

** There is a per-person limit of \$270 each year and a family limit of \$360 (grades 6-12 inclusive). Families are ultimately responsible for saving receipts and keeping track of their own limits*

*** Submitting your paperwork earlier in the summer or when entering the parent/athlete meeting will expedite the process! DO NOT PUT THIS OFF! All paperwork and fees must be on file in order to practice when the season begins!!*

**** Regardless of the EXACT date of the exam, it is SHS policy that ALL physicals expire on 6/30 of the 3rd school year.) MSHSL Physical Examination forms are available at most clinics or at the middle school, junior high or high school offices and online. Pay special attention that the doctor completes the form along with a signature and date of the exam. Please note that incoming 7th graders need a new sports physical for this year. Physicals done before 1/1 preceding the 7th-grade year are NOT acceptable. (See enclosed flyers regarding sports physicals from several local clinics). YOU WILL NEED A PROPERLY COMPLETED, CURRENT PHYSICAL ON FILE BEFORE BEING CLEARED FOR PRACTICE!*
