ADULT AND PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Allied Gardens Little League (AGLL) supports a zero tolerance policy for unsportsmanlike behavior. AGLL and its Parents, Coaches and Players should continually raise the standard of behavior – both on and off the field. Membership in Allied Gardens Little League is a privilege and should carry a sense of pride. Participation in the program will require everyone accept certain responsibilities.

Player Responsibilities:

- I will not verbally or physically abuse any of my teammates, opponents, umpires, officials or coaches.
- I understand that poor sportsmanship, during or after games, will not be tolerated.
- I will remember that winning a game is a result of teamwork and I am a part of that team.

Adult Responsibilities:

- We will encourage sportsmanship by showing positive support for all players, coaches, and umpires at every game and practice.
- We will encourage my child to treat all other players, coaches, and umpires with respect.
- We will not attempt to “coach” or “manipulate” players while they are playing.
- We will not verbally or physically abuse any coaches, umpires, officials, fans or players (including my own).
- We will not attempt to umpire the game by appealing strikes, balls, outs, plays, or other umpire calls, etc.

Course of Action:

AGLL empowers its Managers, Coaches and Board Members to enforce these policies. Should a Parent/Spectator, Player or Board Member not adhere to the principals of this policy, corrective action may be taken. Actions could be as simple as a verbal warning up to disciplinary hearings before the AGLL Board leading to suspension or expulsion from Allied Gardens Little League.

Implementation:

Anyone may file a complaint, in writing and signed, to the President of Allied Gardens Little League.
