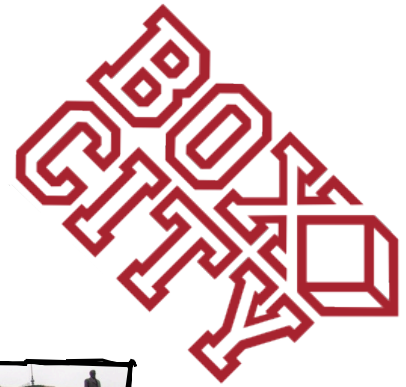


**Box City Vigil 2011

WHAT: Box City Vigil is an annual event held at the Minnesota State Capitol. It is a non-profit organization and is not religiously affiliated. Our primary goal is to raise awareness for youth homelessness in our home state. All profits BCV acquires are redistributed to local teen shelters where they are put to use.

WHY: As many as 1800 youth are homeless on any given night in Minnesota, but there are fewer than 50 beds designated for homeless youth in the Twin Cities. By participating, you are sending a message to capable adults that you care about this and want to make a difference. After you leave in the morning, you will have experienced what it feels like to go a night without your bed and will appreciate it when you take your afternoon nap.



Throughout the night, participants will hear speakers, listen to great music, and learn about homelessness and homeless youth. It's an amazing experience you'll never forget. Don't miss it!

YOU WILL PROVIDE

- Warm Clothing
- Supplies for making your box house (this includes extra boxes, tarps to stay dry, tape, scissors, and blankets)
- Extra Snacks
- Games

PRODUCTS TO BRING FOR DONATED HYGIENE KITS

- Small tube of tooth paste (.85 oz)
- Floss
- Small bottle of shampoo (travel size)
- Small bottle of liquid hand sanitizer
- Deodorant (travel size)
- Tooth brush
- Single use wipes
- Small hand washcloth

Security and safety are our top priority. There will be two Minnesota State troopers and capitol security on the grounds with us the whole night. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK
ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

By signing below, I hereby release Bloomington United for Youth, the Minnesota Coalition for the Homeless, and any employees, officers, or board members of either organization from any liability for damages from illness, injury, and/or death that arises out of, or is connected with, or in any manner related to, my or my minor child's participation in the Box City Vigil event at the Minnesota State Capitol on May 27-28, 2011

By attending the Box City Vigil event on May 27-28, 2011, and by virtue of voluntary appearance on the grounds where the event takes place and/or voluntary participation in activities related to the Box City Vigil event, the attendee hereby agrees as follows:

1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS against the event organizers, staff, supporting organizations, or the Minnesota State Capitol from any and all liability for any loss, damage, expense or injury including death as a result of my use of or my presence on the grounds due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence.
2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY the event organizers, staff, supporting organizations, or the Minnesota State Capitol from any and all liability for any damage to property of or personal injury to any third party, resulting from use of or presence on the facilities.

I represent that:

1. I am 18 years of age or older, or the parents or legal guardian of the minor child listed below.
1. I am submitting this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk declaration voluntarily and of my own free will.
2. I, or my minor child participating in this event, have no physical or emotional problems, nor any history thereof, which will impair my, or my minor child's ability to participate in Box City Vigil in a safe manner.

I understand and agree that it is my responsibility to assess the hazards presented by my, or my minor child's participation in the Box City Vigil, and further agree that I am the ultimate judge as to whether I or my minor child can participate in the Box City Vigil without risk of harm to myself.
4. I understand and expressly assume all the dangers incident to participation in the Box City Vigil, and hereby release all claims, including but not limited to, personal injury, property damage or destruction, and death whether caused by negligence or otherwise and whether for bodily injury, property damage or loss otherwise which I may have against Bloomington United for Youth, the Minnesota Coalition for the Homeless, and any employees, officers, or board members of either organization.
