All field locations for League, Qualifier and State Play will be determined after the August 8th kick-off meeting.

MMFL will make all arrangements dependant on the number of teams and sites provided by the teams to list the field locations on the Schedules posted on-line Tuesday before the start of the first weekend of play for the first two weeks. We then will evaluate the teams and create a new schedule for week three, and determine teams and times for the qualifiers after week three.

Each state tournament level will consist of a minimum of 15 teams and any A State Championship with at least 15 teams will receive a paid A National Berth, additional berths will be available. Awards provided to top finishers in each tier.

Age Divisions

Every Association and team we have talked to wants fall league as an opportunity to work on developing teams.

This includes the requirement for divisions of play, and then allowing for competition to determine just what level a team will reach for League Championship play.

It is simple, what age group will you be part of Next Summer.

If you are still 10 younger on December 31st, then you can play 10U.

If you are 12 or younger on December 31st you can play 12U or above

If you are 14 or younger on December 31st you can play 14U or above

If you are 16 or younger on December 31st you can play 16U or above

Same goes for 18U or graduated from high school in 2011 but,

If you are 19 on December 31st you have to find a women's league to play in, Check the local Colleges.

Team Formation & Rules

Form a team, tell us what level you want to start at, and we will determine the rest for you. Remember, you have free substitution, so you bat your roster for the entire season.. The league will provide a qualifier to determine what level of State Tournament you play. NAFA rules apply, with slight modification listed for free substitution and 5 run per inning at 10U, 12U during three week league play with the 10U through the entire season. Roll the ball to determine home team, at the same time, a player from each team stands at home plate and rolls the ball toward the pitching rubber, closest to the rubber wins.

It is fall ball, we play rain, snow or shine. Games are scheduled at noon, 1:30, 3:00 and 4:30. If it rains, you can wait for better weather and delay the start of your games. Coaches and umpires determine play at the fields. We have no time to make up games, so play the games if you can. Lightning rule is as always, you must wait ½ hour after the last bolt of lightning.
