## **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

### **1. PLAYERS \ BALLS**

#### **MICRO SOCCER (Kindergarten and 1st Grade) Coed teams**

3 VS 3: 3 Children from each team are on the field at one time. **Coaches allowed on field.** Size 3 soccer balls  
Two children play offense. **The other player plays back and gives support (NO HANDS)**

#### **MINI SOCCER (2nd/3rd Grade) Gender teams**

6 VS 6: Children rotate positions. **One coach** from each team is allowed on the field for the first 2 weeks of games. At that point of the season – they will be on the side and not on the field. Size 4 soccer ball.

### **4. PRACTICES**

Practices are one night a week. Practices usually last 60 to 90 minutes with start times of 6pm  
Practices start the week in late April for spring and late August for Fall.

### **5. TRAINING**

Each team will be assigned ½ hour with a trainer on their practice night for 4 weeks of the season

## 8. EQUIPMENT

All children must wear shin pads at all times. Soccer ball and soccer shoes are recommended.

**T-SHIRTS AND SOCKS** will be available for purchase at the first two Saturday games.

## 9. CANCELLATIONS

Games and practices must be stopped if there is lightning in the area.

Fields may be closed during heavy rains. **CLOSING HOTLINE 952-447-9825.**

**Do NOT ignore closing signs**

Cancellations are at the coach's discretion. **The In-house coordinator does not cancel games.**
