



## TRAVEL POLICY 2010-11

All Heat FC Club Travel policies will be followed at all times. We will represent our club by behaving in a respectful and courteous manner when traveling. We need to promote our club in a professional manner to leave our opponents, local and out-of-state, with a good image. Your coach is ultimately responsible for the teams' behavior. Policies and disciplinary actions are as follows.

### **Uniform:**

Players will be expected to follow school dress code and all Heat FC uniform Policies while traveling.

### **Dress Code Violation Disciplinary Actions Are:**

- Player will change into proper attire-immediately. NO exceptions.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense: Warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense: Does not start game
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense: One game suspension
- 4<sup>th</sup> Offense: Tournament suspension

### **Hotel:**

All Heat teams are encouraged to follow "stay-n-play" tournament agreements, stay as a team in the same hotel, and follow the team itinerary. Please make sure your athlete is hydrated, well rested, and provided proper nutrition to enhance the tournament experience and better game results.

Cell phones and other electronic devices will be turned off or turned in at curfew. Parent /Adult Chaperone required in every room.

- **NO** Tobacco of any kind, alcohol, and or drugs.
- **NO** Destruction of hotel property.
  - **NO** Running up and down hallways
  - **NO** Horseplay in the hotel or its elevators.
- **NO** Opposite Sex in a player's room without an adult present.

### **Hotel Violation Disciplinary Actions Are:**

- Dismissed from the tournament and turned over to parents/chaperone.
- If parents are not attending the tournament they must make immediate return travel arrangements for their player.
- Mandatory parent meeting with coaching staff.
- Discipline may result in suspension from games and or team.
