

## NALAX Tournament Rules and Tie Breaking Process

### Format

Grades 7/8 - 12 v 12 full field

Grades 5/6 - 12 v 12 full field

Grades 3/4 - 10 v 10 90 x 50 yard field (6 + goalie inside restraining lines)

### Rules

US Lacrosse youth rules for penalty administration and grade based eligibility.

Grades are current grades for June 2011 (not Sep 2011 grade)

Grade 7/8 will play modified checking (Level A), **25** minute halves, running time, two 2 minute time out per team, 5 minute half time

Grade 5/6 will play no check (Level B), **25** minute halves, running time, two 2 minute time out per team, 5 minute half time. One pass from inside restraining line

Grade 3/4 will play no check (Level B), **20** minute halves, running time, two 2 minute time out per team, 5 minute half time. One pass from inside restraining line

**There is no 3 pass rule. There is no 4 goal differential rule. There is a 1 pass from inside the restraining line rule for grades 3/4 and 5/6.**

**Pass rule resets when the defensive team clears the ball outside their defensive restraining line**

**No stopping the clock unless a time out is taken by a team or umpire.**

### Tie Games:

3 game round robin have no overtime

Playoffs and Championship games - 2 three minute overtime periods, total score. 1 time out per team

If still tied then sudden victory overtime.

### Tie breaking process for play-off seeding:

Head to Head Record

Record against common opponents

Fewest Goals Allowed

Most Goals Scored

Coin Flip

### Rosters:

Each team will supply a roster with player full name, jersey #, DOB, Current Grade, US LAX certification

Only rostered players may participate.

Rosters must be submitted at check-in.
