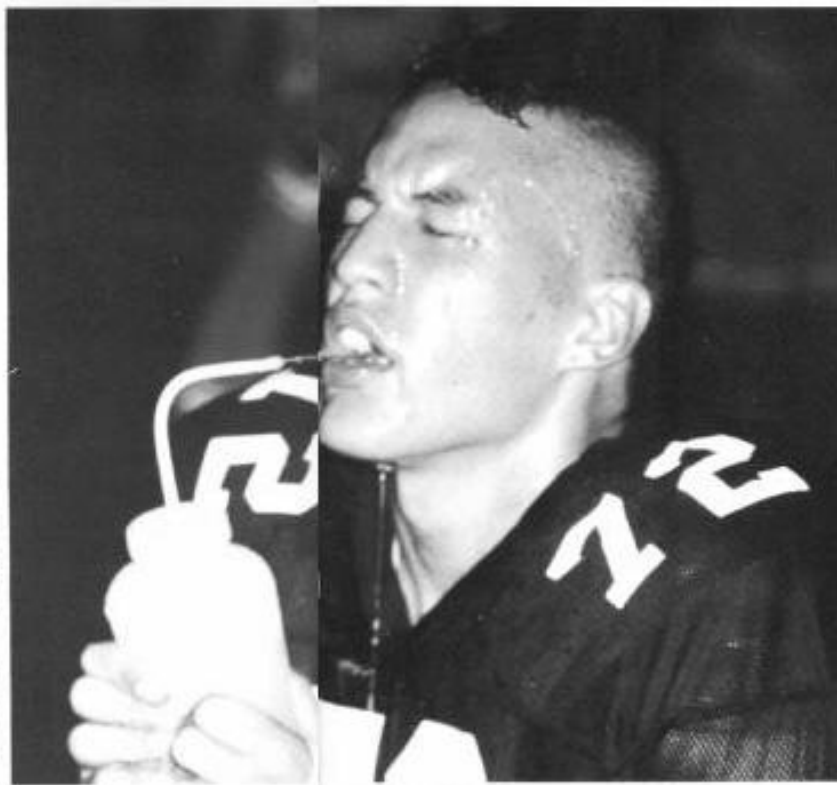


VARSITY FOOTBALL

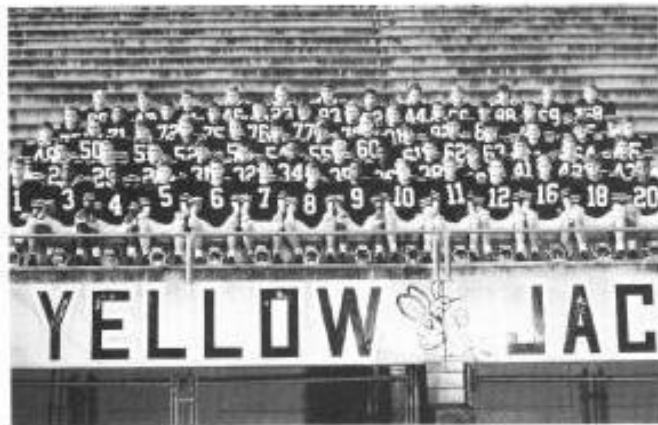
Cooling Off
