- Meeting called to order at 07:00 PM
- Acceptance of minutes motioned by Dea, second by Deb, all approved.

President's report:

- Spring season rapidly approaching.

Past President's report: No report.

Vice-President's report:

- Board nominations, to be discussed at the end of the meeting.
- See unfinished business at the end of these minutes.

Secretary's report:

- Appreciation gift for fire station
- One suggestion was a Hy-Vee gift certificate.
- Ryan suggested coming up with 3 different ideas, & bring back to the board.
- Paul & Mike suggested a \$ 150.00 dollar spending limit.

Treasurer's report:

- Club balance discussed.
- Still need registration collection from Sting team
- Dea will send update to Paul, he will notify those who still owe.
- Process of collecting needs to improve.
- Next budget needs to include paid DOC.
- Once nominations & voting is done, registration & fee process will be reviewed.
- Items needed to buy under capitol improvement account are a mower & frames.
- Duane presented a break-down of expenses & enmities of three mowers from Scag, Hustler, & John Deere.
- After reviewing, a motion to buy the John Deere mower was given by Mike, second by Dan, all approved.
- Mower will be purchased & ready to use for spring.
- Paul was asked if our club wanted to purchase the old mower. Owner gave us a price, & Duane gave him a price, negotiationcontinues.

- Ryan motioned that Duane stay committed to a price of under \$2500.00, second by Jensen, all approved.
- With ENSA, NSL, training, & high school games, etc., on our fields, it would be best for us to purchase two sets of small size frames, & one large size frame. Sets would/need to include nets & wheels.
- Tony at Soccer Internationale has the best price so far.
- VonMende will shop around & see if he could lower prices, & e-mail Ryan the information.
- Jensen made a motion for Ryan to buy two sets of frames, & a set of wheels for existing frames.
- A revised motion was set by Mike for Ryan to purchase two smaller set of frames (U10 and U12 size) & wheels for the existing large frame with a set price limit of \$5000.00, second by Duane, all approved.
- Paul stated whether or not we transfer some funds from the capitol improvement account to the general account.
- Dea asked to have some time to review both accounts, & come up with an amount by the next meeting.
- Need to decide whether to or not to continue to have the Old mans league on our fields.
- Paul & Duane will speak with Leo in finding a better solution to prevent drivers parking & dropping off children down into the soccer complex.

DIRECTOR'S REPORTS

Community Director:

- Jen present a small, bi-weekly school-ad newsletter given out by the Nonpareil.
- Would like to send an ad about CBFC, try-outs, juniors programs, etc.
- Would like to do this for St. Albert schools, & local schools.
- Mike suggested Jen to contact Lisa Wilkins for information on the local public schools.
- Mike also suggested to contact Christy Caniglia from the chamber of commerce about having ads placed.
- Jen will gather more information from the schools, costs, & bring to the next meeting.
- Jensen will assist her with what information text to place in the ads.
- Jen will look into the local smaller town newspapers, too.

Activities Directors:

- Mike has not registered the HH tournament with ISA yet pending on referee bids.
- Week-end is booked with the city.
- The tournament is set for the week-end of October 28-30.
- Several people would like to see it happen the week-end before, if possible.
- Football may still be going on, & depends on UNO's schedule, which won't be confirmed until April.
- Mike asked if we should wait until April to decide whether to keep the Havoc tourney at its set date, or move it back a week to increase chances of better weather.
- Paul stated that we'll think about it some more, & ultimately leave it up to the committee to decide.

- Mike will be purchasing additional DVD training.

STAFF REPORTS

DOC report:

- Jensen stated that I*soccer.org would be a great tool to instill our club philosophies to all families, & at .50 cents per kid, a great way for players to build skills.
- Charts progress, gives the DOC access to each players progress.
- This would help parents to see their child's progress, hopefully alleviating pressure & comparison to other players.
- ISA has a parent education program called “The Alliance”, directed to parents, players, etc., instructing on behaviors, such as sidelines, coaching, other parents, teams, referee's, etc.
- Jensen will be working with coaches in tracking player progress
- Jensen has been talking with CBYSA, as they are changing to level of play.
- They would like to sit down & talk with us in developing players, who needs/wants it, & how to implement those players into our club.
- Our caution is historically, we do our part of action items, but their part in action items always fall through.
- We will continue to work with CBYSA, as long as they commit to action items & agreements.
- Jensen is preparing tri-folds for try-outs, would like to get try-out dates set & scheduled before Omaha try-outs.
- Spring academy – Jordan & Brad willing to help us run the academy, mainly need help with sign-in dates. Cost will be the same.
- They will change it from 8 session to 5 session academy.
- They would like to keep it in the month of April.
- Will CBYSA do their part to help run the academy?
- Cost is zero balance to run.
- Ryan will contact Sharon & check the status of their involvement with this academy.

Registrar report:

- NSL is increasing registration fee's for next fall at .50 cents a player.
- Tara presented information on the State Wars.
- It's an indoor tournament that includes all states.
- Each state has a try-out date, players then selected on teams.
- Iowa has no teams registered so far, & if we are the only ones, then we would be selected.
- Iowa's try-out date is set for 03-12-11.
- It cost \$35.00 to register.
- Once players selected & team is formed, cost would be \$175.00, which includes the whole uniform kit, training T-shirts, & other fees. (\$210.00 total cost).

- Finals would be in Wisconsin.
- Teams are for U8 to adults.
- Register as individuals
- Teams would have their own coaches.
- Uniforms for Iowa would be black & yellow.
- Insurance is paid by State Wars.
- Tara will pass the information to coaches to pass along.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- Nomination committee presented a couple of nominations for the treasurer's position, & the president's position
- Nominated for the treasurer's position was Haley Cox from the committee, & Paul Cox from the floor. Paul Cox declined the nomination. Haley Cox accepted.
- Nominated for the president's position was Ryan Osborn from the committee, & Dan Casson from the floor. Ryan Osborn & Dan Casson accepted.
- Nominations were due in January, but none were available at that time.
- February was to be the voting in of nominee's, induction & transfer of new position holders to be finalized in March.
- Deb motioned to have the voting, induction, & transfer all done at the March meeting, allowing other members time & a chance to vote next month. Second by Dan, all approved.

- Continue to work on communication.
