

Now that you've completed a skills assessment.....

I have a team, what do I do now?

Now that you've assessed, all that is left is registering. You'll get instructions from your team manager about registering online with WHAM.

How do I find a team?

There are a couple of ways to find a team –

- Go out to the WHAM website www.whamhockey.org and input a New Player Classified to let others know that you've been assessed and are looking for a team. Make sure to include as much detail about your experience as possible and respond to ads in your division or above.
- Check out the "Teams Looking for Players" section on the website.
- Touch base with WHAM's New Player Coordinator, Kristen Holmlund at newplayer@whamhockey.org and she can let you know which teams are looking for players. In addition, she can make sure the commissioners have your contact information.
- You can contact commissioner(s) and/or team managers directly, letting them know that you are looking for a team. All contact information is on the website, www.whamhockey.org

Find a team in C2. You obviously have the skill to play at that level and there are many teams looking for players.

Play with the C2 team. You can play at the level you were assessed or above.

What if I'm not happy with my assessed rating?

Assessment ratings are not open to appeal unless there are some extenuating circumstances that the skills assessment committee was not aware of prior to the assessment. Comments and questions may be emailed to Sandi Wewerka, Skills Assessment Chair at C3comm@whamhockey.org.

Can I reassess?

No. Assessment ratings are final.

Since I'm over 40, can I drop one level from my assessed level?

No, you need to skate at least one year at your assessed level before exercising the "over 40" rule. After participating this season, NEXT season you may drop one level.

How long do I have to find a team for this season?

The registration deadline is December 20th.

Should I register with WHAM before finding a team?

That is your call. Registration for USA Hockey, MN Hockey, and WHAM will cost \$55. If you don't find a team, you will not be reimbursed these costs.
