## CPYHA REGISTRATION

### On-Line Registration Begins August 1, 2011

CPYHA will begin accepting online registrations on August 1, 2011. Registration closes September 7, 2011. a \$50 LATE FEE WILL BE APPLIED IF REGISTERING AFTER Sept.7th (excluding Jr. Gold).

### ONLY ON-LINE REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED.

Each player should register based on birth year or skill level.

**STEP 1:** Register on the USA Hockey website at [www.usahockey.com](http://www.usahockey.com). The USA Hockey fee of \$30.00 and the \$10.00 MAHA fee (MN Hockey) will be paid directly to USA Hockey for a total of \$40.00. A registration confirmation message from USA Hockey will be emailed to you (please print a copy for your records). The confirmation number will be needed to register online with CPYHA.

**STEP 2:** Continue the registration process on the CPYHA website at [www.CPYHA.com](http://www.CPYHA.com). Our fees no longer include the \$30.00 paid to USA Hockey or the \$10.00 paid to MAHA (MN Hockey). Payment options include debit cards, Visa, Master Card, Discover, and Pay Pal. Visit [www.CPYHA.com](http://www.CPYHA.com) for more details on the registration process.

### Required Fundraisers

All skaters will be required to participate in the following fundraisers:

#### 1. Candy Bars (per player)

## 2011-2012 VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

Families will be required to work **12** hours during the hockey season for **EACH** registered skater. 5 of the hours required need to be served in the concession stand and the other 7 on committees or other approved activities. The volunteer hours are capped at 40 hours per family.

Your team manager will collect a separate check in the amount of \$200.00 per skater and a parent/guardian signature on a volunteer/mandatory participation statement will be required for **each skater**. These checks will be held and returned to you if **ALL** volunteer/mandatory hours, equipment return and traveling monthly ice bill payments are completed for each skater. If the requirements are not completed in full, your check will be cashed.
