

OYHA 2011-2012 Hockey Season- Fundraising Expectations Parent Commitment Form

Owatonna Youth Hockey Association strives to keep registration costs among the lowest in Southern Minnesota, if not the whole State of Hockey! We fundamentally believe this helps increase participation in a sport that might become very expensive if it weren't for the fundraising we do.

Through higher participation, we feel we are able to field more competitive teams and offer a hockey experience that is better than most associations around. If it were not for the successful fundraisers OYHA runs, and our diligence in controlling our expenses, hockey registration costs would be much higher. Due to all of our great hockey family participation we are able to keep our fees the same as last year!

In fact, in the 2010-2011, OYHA generated more revenue from each of charitable gambling, home tournaments, and concessions than registration. Obviously, every OYHA member participating in these fundraising activities is key to us keeping hockey affordable and continuously offering more for our players. For the coming 2011-2012 season every family will be expected to participate in fundraising in the following ways:

1. **Registration** (One payment or installment plan)
2. **Pancake Breakfast** (50 tickets, 25 tickets or 5 ticket/buy-out)
 - a. Workers for this event are Squirts and Girls 10U plus an adult member of each of their family.
(Please note: you may not do a buy-out if your child is receiving a scholarship)
3. **Pork Commercial Fundraiser** (10 ticket minimum, or buy-out)
 - a. Workers for this event are Pee-Wee and Girls 12U. We will need some parent volunteers also.
(Please note: you may not do a buy-out if your child is receiving a scholarship)
4. **Fair Concession & Parking Lot staffing**
 - a. This will be open to all members of the association.
5. **Tournament Hours participation** (Approx. 4 -7 shifts per player, set-up by team fundraising rep.
All parents are expected to work these shifts with the exception of official team coach(es), (without player on team), if you are not able to work your shifts you are responsible to find someone to cover them. Tournaments are our largest fundraiser. Occasionally we are given the opportunity to host a tournament, districts, or regions that your child's team may not be playing in, we all will have to cover those hours. These hours will be divided and worked by teams that are not playing out of town for the weekend. Remember tournaments are a huge fundraiser for us.
6. **Concession hour's participation**
 - This year the concession stand hours remain at 15 for the first player and 5 hours for each additional player.
 - 5 hours total for official coaches who are also parents (maximum 3 official coaches per team), to be donated coaching Park and Rec.
 - Board member/parents are expected to contribute a maximum of 5 hours total. This is because as a board member you are expected to put a great deal more time in doing various jobs and working different events when asked.
 - Concession stand is open during most multi-game OYHA dates, all high-school games, some park&rec sessions, as well as some dryland events and clean-up in March.

We will be collecting a post-dated check for \$375 for 1st player and \$125 for each additional to be held as collateral against concession hours. For every hour you do not work we will need \$25. Also if you cannot work during your team tournament find someone who is willing to work for you or you will be charged \$25 per hour. If no hours are worked your check will be cashed on 4/30/12. If you do not make arrangements and pay for the partial hours worked your deposit check will be cashed on 4/30/12. If your check is returned by the bank NSF there will be a \$30 fee that you will have to pay along with monies owed in the form of a cashier's check to be paid within 30 days. Your child may be not be allowed on ice if not paid within 30 days. You will not be able to register your child for the following season until all debts are paid. You will get your deposit check back at the end of the year banquet that is held at end of the season if commitments are met.

Associations are starting to include gate fees in their tournament fee instead of paying at the door. OYHA does not pay gate fees so you may be asked to pay that fee before the tournament. Usually that fee is between \$20 - \$30 per family.

OYHA board members appreciate your help in volunteering, to help keep the cost of hockey affordable for everyone and keep Huskies Hockey successful!

Required to complete registration, players will not be allowed to register for OYHA until this form is completed with signature and post-dated deposit check. Please fill out information on next page and give to the person at the registration table for your child. Your registration form must be stamped showing that you signed parent commitment form and gave your deposit check. This will need to be done before you can register your child. Thanks for your help! Let's have a great hockey season! Everyone needs to complete this form including coaches and board members.
