

Blueline Meeting Minutes
April 14, 2011

Daina Lowe will be assuming the Volunteer Coordinator position for the upcoming season.

We need a Concession Manager, as Chris White's term will expire at the end of this season.

The Board reviewed the list of 29 families who did not complete their required minimum volunteer hours. Margaret will send a letter which includes the billing.

Richard Osberg did a great job coordinating Mite Madness. The need for a new photographer for this event was discussed. It was later clarified that neither the City nor the Association selected the photographer. The selection was done by someone on the Mite Madness committee.

Charitable gambling is likely to bring in about \$30,000 this year. The goal of the Blueline is to contribute \$60,000 to WYHA each year.

Bonnie reported on various fundraisers. The General Mills sponsorship is moving ahead. The Shopping Genie will not continue. Food Perspectives will continue, and we will continue to sell hitches at the CMS rink. The restaurant nights will continue next season, but there will be an attempt to get these on a calendar earlier so families can plan. Bonnie said there is a hotel fundraiser which should generate funds, as well as Skate with the Wild, Skate with the Gophers, and Mite Madness.

The monthly newsletter preparation and distribution was difficult, and the format was changed for REACH. Linda hopes to improve these next season.
