

Blueline Meeting Minutes

May 25, 2011

Present: Brenda Senden, Kathy Hewitt, Beth Pruden, Lynda Giesler, Laurie Ahrens, Margaret McKibbin, Daina Lowe

- There were 1,162 players for the 2010-11 season.
- Of the 29 families who were billed for failing to fulfill volunteer hours, 10 remain unpaid.
- Brenda reported there is a new vendor for the WYHA website.
- Laurie distributed minutes from the March and April blueline meetings. She also distributed copies of all comments received from Team Reps and Team Managers regarding the hockey season.
- Margaret reported there is \$9,400 in the Blueline account. The amount of \$30,000 was donated to WYHA in May.
- Kathy suggested the volunteer policy could be amended to 10 hours for single player families; 13 hours for multi-player families. However, there is also a benefit to maintaining the required hours for another season at 10 for single and 12 for multi. This issue will be decided by the Blueline President and Volunteer Coordinator prior to registration.
- Laurie will reserve a room at PIC for the 2011-12 Team Rep meetings (Dec., Jan., Mar.) The Dec. meeting will be carefully planned to cover all aspects of the Team Rep responsibilities. The Jan. meeting will focus on Mite Madness. March will be the drop-off meeting for medical bags and team rep books.
- Laurie will work with the photographer to establish photo dates for 2011-12 and reserve rooms at PIC.
- Margaret suggested a Q & A for new hockey families be added to the website. Everyone agreed this was a great idea and articles from past newsletters could be used.
- Beth, Margaret, and Lynda made plans to transition the treasurer responsibilities.
- Laurie will transition her secretary files and instructions to Brenda.
- Bonnie should provide a list of amounts generated from each fundraiser so this can be shared with Linda for the newsletter.
- The next newsletter should include an article about funds raised through charitable gambling and the blueline fundraising activities.
- The blueline signs used for the restaurant nights should be put in the storeroom. The storeroom is neat and orderly and no spring cleaning is needed – yeah!
