REGISTRATION FORM 2011-2012 HOCKEY SEASON

Registration Notes:

Online Registration Process is on www.stcloudhockey.com (Registration link)

1. Members will first need to register with USA Hockey and pay the applicable fees directly. Registration fees will be assessed to all players born in 2004 and before. USA Hockey fee is \$30/player and MN Hockey is \$10/player. Enter player's name, birth date, address, parents name, phone, and email. You will also need to initial to accept 'Waiver of Liability'
2. Secondly, members will need to register with SCYHA
 - Enter in USA Hockey# from STEP1 (9 numbers + 5 letters), verify correct player information
 - Select Age Division (see chart below)
 - Fill in requested information
 - Payment: Need credit card to pay SCYHA fee (or select you will be paying at a later time)
3. Fill out Consent to Treat form and give to the Age-Level Coordinator (i.e. Bantam, U12, Mite)
4. Provide a copy of your birth certificate to your Coordinator (if did not play within SCYHA previous season)

Registration Fees & Age Level Date Ranges for the 2011-12 Season

Any skater (except Jr. Mites/U8) new to hockey in their first year in the Association will be subsidized \$200

NOTE:

- *The above fees do not include USA/MN Hockey fee's assessed to all players born in 2004 and before, those fees will be paid directly to USA Hockey.*
- *Following initial registration, all travel team players will be assessed a monthly amount once teams are finalized. This monthly assessment includes Pee wee C and Bantam C teams, NOT Squirt C teams.*

Move-up Policy for Travel Teams – For a player to participate in a higher level other than defined; the parent/guardian must submit a written request to the association president prior to the start of dynamics. Each request will be given individual consideration and the approval based on the rules as outlined in the SCYHA Handbook. *SCYHA 2011 Handbook is available on our website – www.stcloudhockey.com.*

Junior Mite – The Junior Mite program is for the first year mite skater and the second year Mite skater who is better suited skating at this level to enhance their hockey skills. This program is geared toward the introduction of the sport of hockey for the beginning player with goals at teaching the sport, individual skating and hockey skills, team camaraderie and the excitement of playing the game.

Squirt C - The Squirt C teams play in the SCYHA Squirt C league and registration includes the cost of entry into three tournaments. Special note on registration fee for the Squirt C player: The initial registration fee is \$325.00 plus a balance of \$325.00 due by November 1st, 2011.

Girls – Girls may only be rostered on one team. For example, girls rostered on a squirt C team are not eligible to play on a Girls U10 team.

Bantams – A complete registration (with payment) must be received by September 1st for the player to be eligible for a Bantam A team. Bantams registering after September 1st will only be eligible for assignment to a Bantam B or C team. Bantam age players registering after September 30th will only be eligible to play at the lowest level offered.

U16 – SCYHA invites players to register even if they are trying out for their high school team and their intention is to play for the SCYHA U16 team if they don't play for their high school. This procedure helps SCYHA determine if a team will be fielded so that scheduling processes can be planned. SCYHA also invites players from other areas within the vicinity of St. Cloud that don't play for their high school to register with SCYHA. Players registering at the U16 level will have their registration fee returned in the event a U16 team is not formulated or if the player chooses to play for his high school.

Scholarships/Financial Assistance – SCYHA does have scholarship funds available for all non-subsidized players. Applications for scholarships can be obtained by contacting the association president or treasurer. Forms are available at www.stcloudhockey.com (under the Forms link), or by calling 320-203-8905.

Ice Time / Team Size - The total amount of ice hours each player and team receives cannot be specifically stated or guaranteed due to the limited amount of time available and changes in schedules of ice users.

Travel Team Tryouts – Each player trying out for a travel team will be assessed an additional tryout fee. The fees for this season are: Bantams \$50, Peewees \$45, Squirts \$35, and Girls \$30. **Please do not include this fee with player registration.** A player not trying out at a level with only travel teams will be placed on the lowest team at their age level. These players are required to attend the last tryout session for forming teams.

Refunds – Registration fees are nonrefundable. Any player quitting an assigned travel team is responsible for any funds owed their assigned team.

MISCELLANEOUS:

Goalies – SCYHA provides goalie camps and instruction for players that are goalies, along with equipment.

Mites and Junior Mites – SCYHA provides jerseys for the players to keep. SCYHA also offers an equipment kit for a \$25.00 rental fee. Included in the kit are: bag, shin guards, gloves and breezers. Additional equipment needed is the responsibility of the SCYHA member. Please contact your age level coordinator for more information.

Mailings – If your email or mailing address changes after registration, please notify the SCYHA at 320 203-8905 with the change. SCYHA uses bulk mail; the postal service does not forward bulk mail.

Required Association Volunteer Hours

By registering for hockey, **SCYHA members (excluding Jr. Mite parents) are agreeing to volunteer a minimum of 4 hours per family (NOT per skater) each year.** Association volunteer hours benefit the association as a whole, not just a particular team. Some examples of Association hours include volunteering for SCYHA hosted tournaments, working the used equipment sale, being an active board member, the SCYHA Golf Tournament, Pizza Fundraiser. There are many different opportunities available throughout the season. Information regarding volunteer opportunities will be available at registration, on our website (www.stcloudhockey.com) and through team managers. **Team Volunteer Hours** that **WILL** count in the required Association Hours would be **coaches, team managers** and **team treasurers**. All other team volunteering does not apply to the Association Hours. Use of volunteers helps us keep the cost of hockey down for you. **If families are unable to fulfill the required number of volunteer hours by March 31, 2012, a charge of \$50 per unfulfilled hour will be assessed to the family's account.**
