

November 2010 GVGS Board meeting Minutes

Minutes:

Brian asked for a resolution authorizing to appoint Bob Mattison and the league attorney. To allow him to file an assumed name as the Golden Valley Girls Softball assoc. And to change the corporate name to add "Slowpitch" as in "Golden Valley Girls Slowpitch Softball assoc". The resolution passed.

Fees for 2011 – Proposal to raise our registration fees to \$70 for next year. Motion to raise our rates by \$10. Motion passed.

Senior Night – discussion to make a senior night, include alumni. Concern of insurance on Alumni. Possibly have them sign a waiver? Motion for Senior and Alumni night on the Monday after end-of season, at Schaper park. Motion passed.

Feed My Starving Children – Calvary event this year. Book the event on a Friday evening, and see how many people we could get. Brian will look into Jan 15th or 22nd. Calvary is not scheduling times yet.

Arc Rule: change it to be 3' from release or keep it as is (arc over the batter's head). USSSA rule is 3' from release and 10' max, which would allow the pitcher to have a consistent arc. Motion was raised to keep the Junior pitching rule to over the top of the batters head, and in the Senior league to adopt the USSSA. Motion passed.

Run rule for Juniors – Explain flipping rule to coaches, for lop-sided scoring games. Address lop-sided games with the coaches on an individual basis. Have the high-scoring and the low-scoring coach report on how the score was achieved. No motion was raised. The run rule will stay as is, and these will be handled administratively.

Rick is looking to have a vendor to come to tryouts with helmets, mouth guards and face masks.
