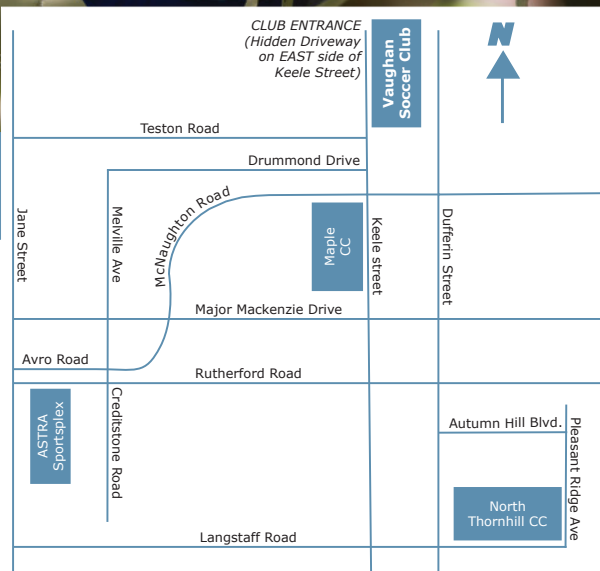

Basic Information: The Vaughan Soccer Club House League program is a noncompetitive league offering soccer to children ages 5 to 18. The Vaughan Soccer Club is affiliated with the Ontario Soccer Association through the York Region Soccer Association.

The Vaughan Soccer Club has By-Laws and Playing Rules that are posted on the website. (www.vaughansoccer.com).

Season: Consists of approximately 26 weeks including playoffs. The House League Indoor Season Kick-Off begins approximately in late October and ends in April / May. Vaughan Soccer Club is a non profit organization that relies primarily on volunteers. All the coaches, Board Members and conveners are volunteers.

Where: All games are played at Astra Sportsplex on either Saturday or Sunday.

Registration Fee: The registration fee includes Uniform, Individual and Team photo as well as trophies for all ages up to 18 year old.

Uniforms: Uniforms include shorts, jersey, and socks which will be provided to the coach for distribution to the registered players on their roster. Shin guards and soccer shoes are mandatory and must be purchased by player.

Can a child play up or down an age division?: Vaughan Soccer Club, under the guidelines of the O.S.A., base the age cut off on the calendar year. Children are placed on teams according to their year of birth and not their grade level in school. A player is allowed to play up one age division as long as a waiver is signed. They may not play up more than one age division. No child can play down to the next division. The player's year of birth is the sole determining factor with the stated exception:

A written request from a doctor indicating that your child has a medical reason necessitating them to play down an age group. **The request should be submitted with the players registration form.**

Team Formation: The Vaughan Soccer Club allows coaches, assistant coaches and sponsors to have only their child on his/her team. Siblings are also placed together. Requests may be made but the two registrations must register together, no later than September 19th, 2011.

Can I request a certain team or coach?: There is no designated spot on the registration form to accommodate special requests because teams are not formed based upon requests. Only negative requests will be considered in team placement. This written request requires to be submitted with your child's application citing the reasons why you do not want your child placed on a specific team. These requests are handled confidentially and should be delivered directly to the Vaughan Soccer Club office. Inconvenient times, carpooling issues, school and player preferences or coach requests are not the criteria for which teams are formed.

Request deadline is September 19th, 2011. All requests are subject to approval by the Vaughan Soccer Club. A player may only request one other player and the request must be reciprocated. Requests MUST be made at the time of the registration.

Volunteering: Vaughan Soccer Club is a non profit organization and relies on volunteers. All of the coaches, Board of Directors and conveners are volunteers. Volunteers are a critical part of our success plus it's rewarding and fun! Be an integral part of our community, contact us if you are considering 'being the difference' in our young athlete's lives! **Our volunteers do what they do, because they care!**

PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT**

(To be signed by participants 18 yrs of age and older)

By signing this document on the previous page you will waive certain legal rights, PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

IN CONSIDERATION of allowing my minor child/ward to participate in the programs, activities and events of The Ontario Soccer Association, the York Region Soccer Association, Vaughan Soccer Club Inc., and various leagues.

I ASSURE TO YOU THAT:

1. I am the parent/guardian of the above named participant having full legal responsibility for decisions regarding the above named participant.
2. I believe that my minor/ward is physically, emotionally and mentally able to participate in the programs, activities and events of the Ontario Soccer Association.
3. I hereby acknowledge that I am aware of the risks and hazards associated with or related to soccer. The risks and hazards include, but are not limited to injuries from:
 - a. Executing strenuous and demanding physical techniques in soccer;
 - b. Dryland training including weights, running and massage;
 - c. Grass, turf and other surfaces including bacterial infections and rashes;
 - d. Falls to the ground due to uneven or irregular terrain or surfaces;
 - e. Collisions with walls and soccer equipment;
 - f. Failure to properly use any piece of equipment or from the mechanical failure of any piece of equipment;
 - g. Extreme weather conditions which may result in heatstroke, sunstroke or hypothermia;
 - h. Contact, colliding or being struck by other participants, spectators, equipment or vehicles;
 - i. Vigorous physical exertion and strenuous cardiovascular workouts;
 - j. Exerting and stretching various muscle groups; and
 - k. Travel to and from competitive events and associated non-competitive events which are an integral part of the organization's activities.
4. Furthermore, I am aware that my child/ward may:
 - a. Sustain injuries in soccer that can be severe, cause spinal cord injuries and even be fatal;
 - b. Experience anxiety while challenging himself/herself during the activities, events and programs;
 - c. Come into close contact with other participants, including the possibility of accidental and unexpected contact;
 - d. Risk of injury is reduced if he/she follows all rules established for participation; and
 - e. Risk of injury increases as he/she become fatigued.

I UNDERSTAND AND AGREE, on behalf of myself, my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin that my signing of this document constitutes:

5. I am registering my child/ward willingly and my child/ward is participating voluntarily in these activities, events and programs. I acknowledge that my copy of this registration form is also my official receipt for income tax purposes, and further acknowledge that if an additional copy of this registration form or receipt is requested at a later date, the Vaughan Soccer Club will levy a service charge of \$25 per additional request.
6. I agree that there are risks in soccer as described above and my child/ward will be exposed to these risks and hazards.
7. **I agree to accept all these risks and hazards** and be responsible for any injury or other loss which my minor child/ward might receive while participating in these events, activities and programs.
8. **If something happens to my child/ward, I release the Organizers** of responsibility for any claims, demands, actions and costs which might arise out of my child/ward's participation. I understand "Organizers" to mean: The Ontario Soccer Association, District Associations, Leagues, Clubs and their directors, officers, members, employees, volunteers, officials, participants, clubs, agents, sponsors, owners/operators of facilities, and representatives.

Executing this agreement will not preclude you from accident insurance coverage, subject to the terms and conditions of The Ontario Soccer Association's insurance policy.
