



Arapahoe Ice Warriors Booster Club Meeting

August 9, 2011

Vice President Lori Lomen called the Arapahoe Warriors Booster Club Meeting to order at 6:35 pm on August 9, 2011.

The following members were present: Lori Lomen, Craig Gaudio, Sue Chiarmonte, Jill Hanafee, and Trish Hoffman.

Minutes from July 12, 2011

MOTION: Sue Chiarmonte made a motion to approve the July 12, 2011 minutes. Trish Hoffman seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer's Report:

Sue Chiarmonte reported no changes from the July 12 2011 report. The available balance is \$18,126.89 with \$2,000 in reserve for the goalie coach from the 2010-2011 season. The Booster Club is waiting to receive the goalie coach's invoice. \$6,000 is in reserve for the 2011-2012 season for scholarships.

Old Business:

- Tournament Software: Software continues to be researched: no organization that we have contacted uses tournament software. Jill Hanafee will research creating a database application tailored to our tournament specifics.
- Midget AA Labor Day Weekend Round Robin: Trish Hoffman, Tournament Director, distributed an update. Major AA division is full with six teams. Minor AA has four teams; room for two more. Volunteers are needed to work the check-in table: will contact the AYHL Midget/Minor AA teams for parent volunteers. Bottled water donations are needed for the referees/scorekeepers. Trish Hoffman will seek donations from stores.
- Early Bird Tournament (EBT): Trish Hoffman distributed an update. EBT information is posted on the Booster Club website, and at Family Sports Center (FSC) rink.

- Ice Slots: 46 ice-slots have been secured at FSC, and 19 at South Suburban Ice Arena.
- Divisions: Posted on AYHL website: PWA, PWAA, Bantam A, Bantam AA, Minor A, Major A.
- CAHA application: Trish will submit application with payment.

Lori Lomen will contact C.H.E. Sportswear to sell tournament apparel at FSC during the tournament. Trish will contact YSPN (tournament photographer) and PSA Auction. Kathy Dosen will oversee team trophies. Championship banners and tracker boards purchases to be coordinated with Dave Kahn. Squirt parents will be asked to donate bottled water. **We need a volunteer to coordinate the silent auction.**

- Pancake Breakfast: Jill Hanafee has confirmed with the Avalanche Grill Manager, Randy, that we can have our breakfast fundraiser on Saturday morning, (9/24) and Sunday morning (9/25). Jill suggested a name change to “Early Bird Breakfast Buffet.” Craig Gaudio volunteered to oversee the Breakfast fundraiser. Jill will set up a meeting with Craig, Randy, and Jill to go over details.
- Raffle Fundraiser: Lori Lomen explained “Calendar Winners.” Each raffle ticket could be sold at \$10 for one chance to win \$20 (or \$5/ticket, \$10 payout...). Each travel hockey player would be required to sell a certain amount of tickets. Winning tickets would all be drawn at the same time under the direction of our Games Manager, Greg Lomen. Winners could be announced either all at once or periodically, with payout throughout the year or limited to our hockey season. Craig Gaudio suggested a 50 50 raffle with ½ payout to the winner, and ½ to the booster club.

New Business:

- CCYHL: nothing to report.
- Lori Lomen reported that practice jerseys, decals, and C’s and A’s for game jerseys have been ordered.
- Trish Hoffman presented a fundraiser opportunity for Arapahoe Hockey teams by selling DU game tickets. This information will be posted on the AYHL website.
- The Booster Club discussed who receives the money from the Colorado Avalanche CAHA Player Pass Program. No money to date has been received by the Booster Club, however the Ice Office may have received money.
