Welcome to the 2011-2012 Season of Jaguar Hockey! We are once again excited for the new season. We hope you are ready for some hockey!

Registration for the 2011-2012 Season will once again be on-line. By registering early, we have given you the opportunity for a discount. We hope you will take advantage of that discount.

USA Hockey has singled out the Jaguar Hockey Club as one of just 46 in the entire country that have successfully grown youth hockey participation by meeting USA Hockey's 2 & 2 Challenge for the past two seasons. Our commitment to youth hockey growth continues again this season with our Blackhawks partnership in conjunction with our Minor Hawk program, twice a week Pre-Hockey classes, Come Play Hockey free clinics, and expanding our In-House/ADM program to minor 6u, minor 8u and major divisions.

As you look through the Fall 2011-2012 season information please note the following:

- The NIHL season has been extended from February to the end of March. Although game limits are staying the same, the ratio of practices to games will increase. Fees for this season have increased slightly but this incorporates practice ice for all travel and travel house teams through the end of March.
- Changes in USA Hockey rules include:
 - *The checking age has moved from Peeewe to Bantam.
 - *Tag up offside for Bantams and Midgets.
- New to the club will be optional Wednesday Skills Clinics for those looking for more ice touches. Skills topics include defense, skating, stick handling, and goalie instruction.

The Jaguar Board of Directors and I also promise to increase communication with you. We will be continue weekly Jaguar updates to your email along with a General Meeting at the beginning of the season and increased communication through your team manager. Jaguar Travel Hockey

The Jaguar Hockey Club participates in the Northern Illinois Hockey League, which is the largest Tier II Hockey League in Illinois. The travel hockey season includes a seeding round that begins mid-September and runs through the end of October. Teams then enter into their regular game season which ends in late February or the beginning of March, with play-off games taking place in March and the Championship weekends ending the season in late March. *This is an extended season from 2010-2011.*

Travel hockey teams also participate in several tournaments per season, which can either be local or out of state that would require overnight lodging. Travel hockey with the Jaguars is competitive, integrating development, opportunity for advancement, good sportsmanship, dedication and commitment, as well as academic success. The Jaguar Hockey Club anticipates 2011-2012 travel players will be on the ice an average of 4-5 times per week including 1 power skate and/or goalie clinic, plus 1-2 practices per week, plus 1-2 games. On ice learning will be supplemented by 20 weekly agility/core group training sessions as part of our off ice conditioning program.

Socks are included with the fees.

Jaguar Travel B/Travel House Hockey - Squirt, Peewee, & Bantam

The Jaguar Hockey Club Travel House teams will participate in the Northern Illinois Hockey League for the 2011-2012 Season. The season includes a seeding round that begins mid-September and runs through the end of October. Teams then enter into their regular game season which ends in late February or early March, with play-off games taking place in March and the Championship weekends ending the season in late March.

This is an extended season from 2010-2011.

The Jaguar Hockey Club anticipates 2011-2012 House players will have an ice schedule that includes 20 weeks of power skills, 1 practice per week, and a normal schedule of games.

On ice learning will be supplemented by 20 weekly agility/core group training sessions as part of our off ice conditioning program.

Evaluations will take place the beginning of September. Exact dates and times will be announced mid-August. Evaluations will be over a one day period.

Jaguar In-House (ADM)

The Jaguar In-House Program is the first step in the Jaguar Hockey Club Development program. The Jaguar In-House program is designed to transition the Pre-Hockey skater to Travel or Travel House team play. Your skater will begin to apply the basic hockey skills learned previously into a game environment.

Join Coach Jerry Fronck as he uses American Development Model (ADM) principals to teach our in-house skaters. Levels include Minor 6U (6 and under), Minor 8U (8 and under), and Major (9 and up). The Jaguar Hockey Club realizes that each in-house skater has a different commitment level. So, we are offering a base in-house schedule and then an ala cart of options to fit to your skaters needs.

In-House Package:

- Wednesday Practice
- Sunday Cross-ice or half-ice games depending on level
- Ice from mid-September through the beginning of March
- Jersey and socks
- Jaguar Jingle Bash Tournament in December
- For all 8U's, Jr. Hawk Game.

Cost: \$950 per skater

Please note: There is **NOT** a goalie discount for this program.

Try-outs will be held in late October for 1-2 teams to participate in either the SSSL Mite division or the NIHL Mite jamborees. Both leagues are still finalizing details. This option will include games and additional practices and will be in addition to a skater's in-house schedule.
