CODE OF CONDUCT:

- 1) All coaches must wear a helmet when on the ice during practices only! You will be responsible for any fines that you receive.
- 2) Coaches must remain members in good standing throughout the season, including but not limited to keeping their accounts current.
- 3) Coaches can not bring other siblings out to coach with them unless they are register student coaches.
- 4) If you have issue, please bring it to the coaching committee before it gets out of hand.
- 5) Be a positive role model to your players. Coaches must set a positive example at practices and games.
- 6) Be generous with your praise; be consistent and honest; be fair and just; do not criticize players publicly; learn to be a more effective communicator and coach; do not yell at players.
- 7) Organize practices that are fun and challenging for your players. Always encourage your players to play as a team. You must stress the participation of all the players.
- 8) Coaches are responsible for the conduct of the players on their team. They will maintain order and control among all team members before, during, and after all games/practices.
- 9) All coaches must provide an environment for the players that are free of alcohol, tobacco, and other illegal drugs.
- 10) The teams will be playing under Minnesota's (HEP) program which promotes sportsmanship, skill development, and fair play. I agree to follow the guidelines of this program.
- 11) All coaches will also follow the Mitron Developmental program per the appropriate level.
