1.0 Purpose

This policy establishes the guidelines regarding a renegade basketball team forming within the Big Lake School District.

3.0 Policy

It is the policy of the Big Lake Youth Basketball Association (BLYBA) to not support any basketball team that is not offered by the BLYBA organization for grades three (3) through eight (8).

- 3.1 The BLYBA will not provide a renegade team with equipment, gym space or insurance.
- 3.2 The BLYBA will notify the Minnesota Youth Athletic Services (MYAS) of any renegade team forming in the Big Lake School District and request the team be banned from all MYAS sponsored tournaments.
 - 3.2.1 The renegade team’s head coach and assistant coaches’ names will be provided to MYAS.
- 3.3 The BLYBA will notify all basketball associations in the Big Lake surrounding area of a team’s renegade status and request the team be banned from their tournaments. It is at the discretion of the Board of Directors to notify any other basketball association of the team’s renegade status.
- 3.4 The BLYBA will notify Big Lake Community Education that the renegade team is not covered under the BLYBA insurance policy.
- 3.5 In the event a renegade team is granted legitimate status by MYAS, the team must provide proof of insurance and a signed waiver by all parents before the renegade team can scrimmage a BLYBA team.

4.0 Definitions

- 4.1 Renegade Team – A team that is formed with players that did not initially try out for a BLYBA traveling team or tried out and the parents decided to form their own team.
