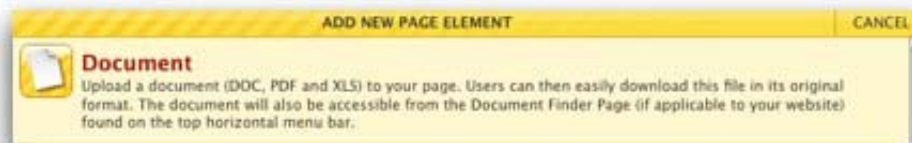
How do I add an animated image to the website?

Adding an animated image to your website:

1. **Login** to your organization's website
2. Create a new page and label it "Website Assets". Go ahead and leave the new page "disabled" as it will be a holding page for the GIF file (or any other assets you wish to upload and reference in the future).
3. Click **Add Page Element**



4. From the menu, select the **Document** page element (it will also accept .GIF files)



5. Title the Document
6. Click **Browse** and locate the animated file you saved to your computer
7. Click **Create This Page Element**
8. Hover your mouse over the title link for the document you just created
9. Right click and select **Copy Link Location**
10. Go to the page you wish to add the animated image (you need to have editing or owner permissions for this page)
11. Click **Add Page Element**



12. Select the **Code** page element from the menu



13. Right Click and select **Paste** (this will paste the link location for the animated file) (example link location: <http://s3.amazonaws.com/assets.ngin.com/attachments/document/0006/6803/games-animated-gif-002.gif>)
14. Add `` after the last letter of the link location URL
16. The format for the complete code would look like this:



17. Click **Create This Page Element**

18. Your animated picture will now display and will take the actual size of the original image
