## How do I make a team roster or stats private so only select individuals can view the data?

Currently Roster/Player Stats, Game Schedule, and Statistics tools can be enabled or disabled. Tools that are "enabled" can be viewed by any general users of your website. Tools that are "disabled" are only available to users with Edit and Owner Permissions to the team page (such as the coach or manager). You can set a tool to disabled and still allow for specific users to 'view' the data without giving them editing permissions.

**To accomplish this, you would first set the roster/player stats, game schedule, or statistics tool to a 'disabled' status. Follow these instructions to disable a tool:**

1. **Log in** to the website and go to the team page you have permissions for (you must have at least Page Owner permissions).
2. Ensure you're in **Edit Mode**



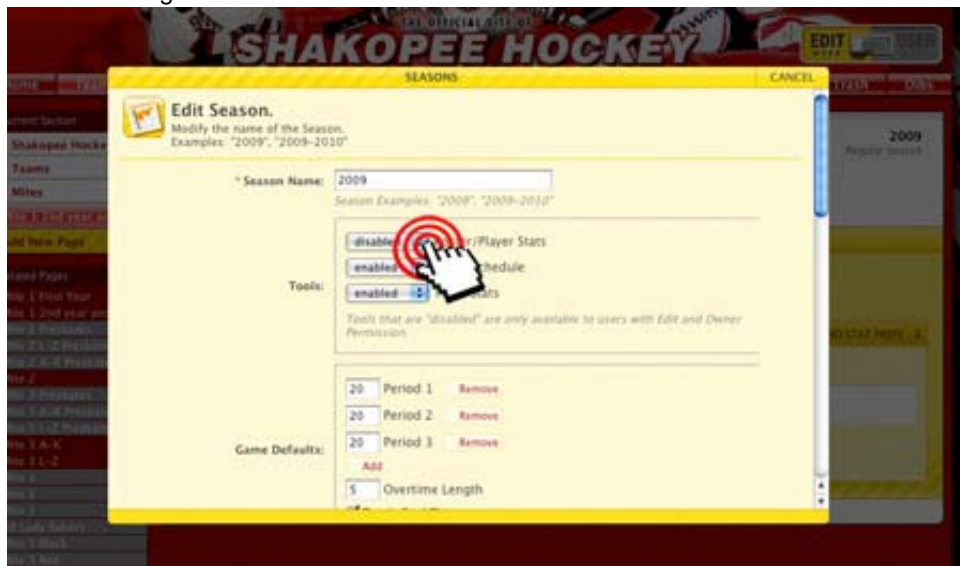
3. Click the **Seasons** tab



4. Click **Edit Details and Stat Prefs**



5. Use the drop down next to the tool to change to disabled.
  - This would allow someone with editing permissions the ability to still track stats or add a roster, but they would not be viewable for general users.



To make any of the disabled tools viewable for select individuals, you will need to create a widget to display the specific data you would like. You can display the widgets on a public or private page.

1. **Scenario #1:** You would like the individual player stats disabled, but would like to make the roster available to all users.
  - Disable the Roster/Player Stats tool as shown above
  - [Create a Roster Widget](#) and place the widget on your team page
2. **Scenario #2:** You would like individual player stats disabled, but would like only parents/specific group of people to view the team roster.
  - Disable the Roster/Player Stats tool as shown above
  - Create a subpage below the team page called Roster. Click the permissions tab on this page to make it 'Private' and then assign a group or specific individual(s) with 'viewing' permissions for the page.
  - [Create a Roster Widget](#) and place the widget on this private page.
3. **Scenario #3:** You would like to keep the Team Stats disabled, but have them viewable to select individuals.
  - Disable the Statistics tool as shown above.
  - Create a subpage below the team page called Statistics. Click the permissions tab on this page to make it 'Private' and then assign a group or specific individual(s) with 'viewing' permissions for the page.
