



GOALIE SCORING AND RATING

1. For each game the goalies save and shot stats will be kept.
2. A running Save Percentage, Goals Against and shutout will be kept for goalies amongst their level.
3. At completion of all regular games a point system will be used to determine standings among goalies.
4. Final Points Scoring will be as follows:
 - a. Points will be awarded for each place per goalie at each level (1st, 2nd and 3rd place of each category)
 - b. Example of a 4 goalie Division and points awarded for Save Percentage:
 1st Place =4 points 2nd Place=3 points 3rd Place=2 point 4th Place =1point
 - c. Shutouts in a game will be awarded a 0.5 point per shutout.

5. EXAMPLE:

- a. After all games have been played the goalie has accumulated the following:

• 2 shutouts	=	1 point
• 3 rd place in Save Percentage	=	2 point
• <u>1st place in Goals Against</u>	=	<u>4 points</u>
• Total		7 Points

Goals-Against Average This is the number of goals allowed per 18 minutes played, rounded to two decimal points.

The Formula: Multiply the number of goals allowed by 18 and divide by the total number of minutes played.

The Example: If you allowed 25 goals in 108 minutes your GAA is (25 times 18 = 450. Divided by 108 = 4.16).

Save Percentage This number expresses a goalie's success based on the number of shots he faces.

The Formula: Divide the number saves made by the number of shots on goal. Work it out to 3 decimal places.

The Example: If you faced 45 shots and allowed 5 goals, your save percentage is .888 (40 saves divided by 45 shots = .888).
