

Food: Food is not permitted in the rink area or locker rooms at any time. This includes donuts, pretzels, cookies, popcorn, etc. Please note that popcorn is not allowed anywhere in the building.

Pets: No PETS Allowed in Rink

Parking: No parking is ever allowed on the driveway leading to the rink parking lot. Should the lot be full, you may either park on the grass, or you may temporarily double park behind someone that you know.

Grid or Fire Zone: Cars are not permitted to enter the grid area near the rink steps for any reason. This is a fire zone, not a loading zone, or drop off zone. This will be strictly enforced.

Rink Area: Please do not leave rubber matted areas. All non-rubber matted areas are off limits at all times. No one is permitted to walk in the area past the engine room. Only coaches, and officers of the club are permitted to be in or walk to the home bench area.

Parents With Children: We welcome you to bring your young children, but they must be supervised at ALL TIMES. They MUST stay in the lounge with you. The stairs, lobby, and rink area are off limits to running and playing. They cannot leave the lounge without a parent, and will not be allowed to run through the building. There will be zero tolerance toward individuals not following this policy at all times.

Ice Time: No group is permitted on the ice before their scheduled time without permission from the Rink Management. Players cannot enter the ice without a certified coach. The coach must wear a helmet and be in visible contact with the players on the ice at all times. Sending the players on the ice while the coach is in the locker room putting on skates is not acceptable. ALSO, parents are STRICTLY forbidden to walk out on the ice during an injury, altercation, etc. ONLY USA approved officials, coaches, and Rink Management may go out on the ice.

Management In the Building: The Rink Management would appreciate assistance from coaches and parents to make sure that rink policies when visitors are present during games, are followed.

Hockey Goals: Please do not lay the goals down on the ice. This can and will damage the netting and more important the frames. Use Shooter Tutors.

Water Bottles: Please do not empty water bottles out on the ice.

Locker Rooms: It is mandatory that locker room assignments are followed correctly when they are issued. You will find them on the door as you enter the rink area. Locker rooms are expected to be kept relatively clean.

Locker Room Cleanliness: Coaches will be expected to maintain a reasonably clean locker room, and can be held responsible for any excessive mess or damage.

Floor Hockey: An ever growing problem. Ball playing, stick handling, shooting, running, and FLOOR HOCKEY is NOT allowed anywhere in the building.

Equipment: Cones and equipment must be put away and secured at the end of each ice slot.
