

AHA FUNDRAISING POLICY

The purpose of this policy is to clarify the expectations and requirements of the members of the Aberdeen Hockey Association. The AHA relies upon fundraising to help defray costs of running a hockey association.

SEASON: 2011-2012

1. MANDATORY FUNDRAISING COMMITMENTS:

a. Annual Raffle Ticket Program:

- i. Each player in the association is required to purchase a book of raffle tickets for \$150 by December 1st.
- ii. The \$150/book goes directly to AHA.
- iii. The raffle tickets will be available for pickup on or about November 10th.
- iv. All required raffle books must be picked up by December 1st.
 1. If payment is not received by 12/1, the player will not be allowed to participate in AHA activities (practice or games) until resolved.
- v. If you would like to purchase additional books, you can pick these up later; just adhere to the deadline of February 1st for handing in the tickets.
- vi. Tickets must be turned into the fundraising contact at your respective level by February 1st.
- vii. The tickets are yours. You can either sell them to earn cash back to defray costs of the hockey program or other household expenses, or you can simply put your name on the tickets and be entered into the drawing.
- viii. If you choose to sell the tickets, you must follow the ticket pricing that is printed on the ticket.
- ix. The money that you collect for the sale of the raffle tickets is yours.
- x. Winners of the Raffle will be announced at the last home Boys Varsity game.

b. Family Max Requirement:

- i. The family max will be 1 book/player with a maximum of 3 books per family.

c. Purchasing Additional Booklets:

- i. A member can purchase as many booklets as they wish for the \$150/book price.
- ii. By doing this, you have the potential to collect up to \$250/book. This can certainly be used to help mitigate hockey related expenses.

d. Additional Fundraisers:

- i. The intent is that the raffle ticket program funds the entire fundraising needs for AHA.
- ii. Additional fundraisers may be developed and activated if additional revenue is needed to fund the hockey program.

e. Buy Out Option:

- i. For the family that is not able to or refuses to participate in the fundraising activities for AHA. Provide payment to AHA in the amount listed below.
 1. Development Level: \$250/player
 2. State League Level: \$250/player
