Before Tryout Day

Pre –Register!

 Player must register with USAV via the AZ region site and pay their fee! : www.azregionvolleyball.org
 Ensure all **paperwork** is in order for both Shenu & the AZ Region as indicated on the sites!!

Tryout Day

Check In	When you arrive – check-in! Pay the tryout fee. Players get their tryout shirt and tryout info packet. Ensure all required paperwork is in order!
Welcome & Opening	Club Director will welcome you to the tryout and give players and parents a brief overview of the tryout process.
Volleyball Skill Assessment	After breaking into groups, players will stretch and then be evaluated on specific volleyball skills – such as hitting, passing, serving etc...
Physical Assessment	All players are required to take a physical assessment so we can determine your athleticism, stamina and strength – all important aspects of the volleyball game. See the website for what we will be testing for so you can practice beforehand!
Initial Playing Assessment	Players will be evaluated in game conditions. Play your best!!
1st Recommendation	Although we wish we could take every player that attends a tryout, the nature of running a competitive volleyball club does not allow us to. Evaluating Coaches will make their recommendations to the Club Director of the players that should continue on to the Advanced Assessment session. Players being invited to continue will have their TRYOUT # posted on the wall.
Advanced Playing & Assessment	Players will be further evaluated in game conditions. Competition will be tougher at this point. You will be evaluated on many aspects, such as playing ability, attitude, hustle, volleyball I.Q. & determination! Now's the time to step up. Parents are invited to a presentation about the club by current 'parents' and will be happy to answer questions!!
Final Recommendation & Team Offering	Final recommendations will be submitted to the Club Director. We will be filling up our 'even' age teams first (12,14,16,18's). 'Odd' year teams may be created at the discretion of the Club Director. Players will be recommended for our "1" and "2"'s teams at each level. Some players may be placed on a call back list and contacted if positions become available. We will POST the team offerings by TRYOUT # on the wall. If the player qualifies, they may be invited to play 'up' (Eg. A 13 year old playing on a 14 year old team.).
Meet Your Coach	Based on the offered team assignments – go meet your coach. They will discuss the team, expectations and next steps.
Closing & Commitment Fee	The Club Director will have closing comments. If you accept the team offering, you will be asked to pay a commitment fee. This will be applied towards the overall club season tuition.
