

Shakopee Sabers vs. Minnetonka Skippers

The Saber's 9B football team beat host Minnetonka on another blustery day. The strong winds didn't affect the Saber's ground game. The Skippers got the opening kick-off and were driving when Tyler Ho blitzed around the end hit the quarterback jarring the ball free that Corey Fern pounced on. The Saber's offense scored four plays later on Seiha Pril's 40 yard sweep. On the ensuing kick-off Alex Coleman raced down the field and dislodged the ball from the returner, Luke Brusletten recovered the ball at the Skipper's 27 yard line. Rob O'Loughlin punched the ball in from a yard out six plays later giving the Sabers an early 16-0 lead. Seiha Pril and Jonah Blue stopped the Skipper's next drive. They were deep in Saber's territory when Blue got a hand up to deflect a pass that Pril was able to intercept. The Skippers were able to get some success on their next drive. They scored on a 31 yard run to cut the lead to 16-8, however it took the Sabers only 4 plays to go 67 yards with O'Loughlin scoring on a 28 yard run. With only seconds remaining in the half, the Skippers connected on a 30 yard field goal to make the score 24-11 at halftime. The Sabers got the second half kick-off, but on a mishandled snap the Skippers had the ball on the Saber's 30 yard line. On 3 and 10, Joe Guimond read the sweep and tackled their back for a 6 yard loss. Minnetonka decided to punt; the snap went sailing over the head of the punter for a 21 yard loss. O'Loughlin got his third touchdown of the day a short time later. The defense continued to make running and throwing tough on Minnetonka. The Skippers only managed 14 yards on 9 carries in the second half. Pril got his second touchdown of the game late in the third quarter. Alex Coleman then found Pril in the end zone on the two point conversion to put the game out of reach. Tyler Ho finished the scoring on a nifty 21 yard run up the middle. The Sabers had eight different ball carriers rack up 383 yards on 53 carries. The Sabers will travel to Red Wing next to face off against their 9A team.
