

Shakopee Sabers vs. Red Wing 9A

The Saber's 9B football team lost a close battle with Red Wing's 9A team. Red Wing built an early lead that the Sabers couldn't over come. It took the Wingers only 3 plays to score on a 62 yard run. On the Saber's first drive, a Red Wing defender stepped in front of a pass from Alex Coleman to Seiha Pril setting up the Winger offense deep in Saber territory. The Wingers scored 4 plays later to make the score 16-0. On Red Wing's next drive Joe Guimond dislodged the ball from the running back, Andrew Thorson fell on the loose ball. However, the Winger's defense intercepted another Saber's pass. Red Wing then drove down the field, but on 4th and 2, Tyler Ho stopped the runner short of the first down. The Sabers started the drive on their own 11 yard line. After a couple of nice runs by Ho, Joe Guimond broke free on a 3 wedge for a 46 yard scamper. Seiha Pril scored on a 15 yard sweep two plays later, cutting Red Wing's lead to 16-6. The drive covered 89 yards in 8 plays. The Sabers were forced to punt on their first possession of the second half. Red Wing scored one play after the very short punt on a 28 yard run. The Saber's offensive answered right back on a 12 play 72 yard drive that was capped off by Ho's 7 yard sweep. Ho added the 2 point conversion making it 24-14. The Wingers then scored on a 13 yard dump pass to the tight end. On the next drive the offensive line of Jonah Blue, Jessie Jimenez, Matt Lynch, Corey Fern, Michael Chance, Andrew Thorson, Jordan Daniels, and Ryan Carlson took control of the line of scrimmage. After consecutive runs of 30, 12, and 14 yards the Sabers were in scoring position. Tyler Ho followed the line up the middle on a 3 yard wedge. The Sabers were down 32-20 with 4 minutes to go. The defense did its job and stuffed the option on 4 and 3 at midfield. After a completed pass from Alex Coleman to Andrew Thorson the Saber were primed to score again, but two plays later Tyler Ho's half back pass was intercepted sealing the Wingers first victory of the year. Tyler Ho led all rushers with 152 yards on 26 carries. He also led the defense in tackles. The Sabers final game will be under the lights against Northfield.
