Our Philosophy

Commitment Expectations

All teams are made up of skilled players and have a dedicated coaching staff and their own full court for practice. Practices last 2 hours and are run twice a week from December until June. Tournaments

Teams selected will compete at the open and club levels in USA events. These teams will participate in regional tournaments, as well as out of area weekend tournaments. Most tournaments are within a 2 hour drive; however, we do attend some events that require travel and overnight accommodations. AAU (Area) teams will play local tournaments with no overnight travel.

Teams in the open division will be given the opportunity to compete for a USA National Championship bid. All teams have the option to participate in the AAU National Championships. Both championships are held in June.

Tryout Registration

Go to www.libertybelles.com and click on the "Tryout Information" to register online. You can also fill out the form and bring it with you on the day of tryouts; however, it is recommended that you register online for faster processing. The non-refundable fee for tryouts is \$40. This can be paid by cash or check the day of the tryout (with the tryout form) or can be paid by credit card online; please note that the online fee is \$43 to cover processing charges. Checks are made payable to "Liberty Belle Volleyball Club."

In order to tryout, you must register with KRVA. Go to www.krva.org and open the link "Registration Instructions". Please make sure you do this before tryouts. You **MUST** have you USA ID card with you at tryouts. If you register online, your USA registration must be completed before completing our online registration.
