



JYBA – TRAVEL TRY-OUTS

The 4th 5th and 6th grade try-outs will be at the JHS Aux 2 Gym
Thursday, November 3rd from 5:30-9:00pm.
The 3rd grade try-outs will be November 5th from 5:00-6:00pm.

- Tryout schedule: All participants should arrive 15-30 minutes prior to their scheduled try-out for registration purposes.

- November 5 - 3rd Grade Travel Try-Outs – 5:00pm-6:00pm Aux 2

Travel schedule commitment in addition to the in-house schedule:

- All participants trying out for the JYBA Travel teams must reside in the Jackson Township school district.
- All travel teams will have a 90 to 120 minute practice each week.
- All travel teams will participate in the Tallmadge Rec Center League with games played on Sundays between November 19th and January 22nd (games scheduled from 8:00 am through 8:00 pm)
- All travel teams will play a Northeast Ohio weekend tournament schedule per the following:
 - 4th, 5th and 6th grade travel teams will play in 5 tournaments
 - 3rd Grade travel team will play in 4 tournaments
- Costs and Fundraisers:
 - All travel players must participate in one fundraiser — the Holiday Hoop-la. Players in grades 4-6 are required to raise a minimum of \$100. Players in grade 3 are required to raise a minimum of \$75. More information will be distributed in December. The JYBA will incur the cost of travel team uniforms and registration fees for sanctioned leagues and tournaments.
 - Hotel expenses and travel costs will be borne by each family. All travel teams will endeavor to stay at the same hotel for out-of-town tournaments.

- Travel team parents will be expected to volunteer their time to sell 50-50 tickets during at least one high school home game during the 2011-2012 season. More information will be distributed in November. Polar Bear Classic:
- Travel team parents will be expected to volunteer their time at the JYBA Polar Bear Classic Travel Youth Basketball Tournament. Youth travel team coaches along with the JYBA PBC Tournament Directors will coordinate the times/gyms/responsibilities with the families of your team. This is one of two major fundraisers that the JYBA holds and will need volunteer help from each travel team family.
