SKATERS WHO HAVE PASSED THE ISI FS 4 TEST AND/OR HAVE COMPETED AT THE USFS NO TEST LUTZ LEVEL AND ARE 7 YEARS OR OLDER. SKATERS MUST HAVE AN ACCEPTABLE LEVEL OF BODY AND SPACIAL AWARENESS

HIGH SESSIONS –

ICE ETIQUETTE GUIDELINES

THIS IS A **ZERO** TOLERANCE POLICY

Lack of compliance to the following policies shall result in removal from the ice. In the event of such action, there will be no refund or credit for lost sessions.

- Skaters are required to check in before stepping on the ice.
- Food and/or drink are **not** permitted on the ice (exception – plastic water bottles).
- It is the responsibility of all skaters to keep the ice area clean. Remove all belongings (tissue, water bottles, gloves, etc.) before exiting the ice.
- There is to be no stopping or standing on the ice except against the railing. This includes stopping to “speak” with people in the viewing area. You may leave the ice if you need to use the restroom or adjust equipment.
- **PARENTS** are restricted to the upstairs viewing area at all times. Any parent observed instructing a skater (including using gestures from the viewing area) will result in the removal of that parent and skater from the facility. There will be no refund or credit for unused sessions or classes.
- iPods and any devices with ear pieces or headphones are **PROHIBITED** on the ice.
- Music will be played in the order in which the skater has signed the music sign-in sheet. Programs will be played once per session. All programs will be played all the way through. There will be no stopping and starting for any reason.
- During a lesson, coaches have the right to cut into the music line-up.
***Rule: 2 coaches / 1 skater**
- The Skater **“IN PROGRAM”** has the right of way. That skater must wear the designated yellow belt so that all other skaters will recognize the skater “IN PROGRAM”. It is the responsibility of everyone to be aware of the skater “IN PROGRAM.” When a skater is “IN PROGRAM” they may say, “program” if another skater is in their way. Any other language in this situation is unacceptable.
- All corners of the arena are considered to be the “Lutz” zones. There is to be no spinning or practicing of crossovers in those areas (exception - skater “In Program”). Keep all spins to the center of the ice.
- Kicking the ice, kicking the boards, shouting, foul language or arguing with other skaters or coaches will not be tolerated.
- At the end of sessions, the skaters will leave the ice promptly.
