2. For this example, we point to the third person in the list, David Smith, a Level 3 whose card is current but who needs to take a module. You would select your own name. Note the use of color-coding in the web site. Clicking on an entry opens up the detail window below...we see David took all three levels in 2009-10. His card is current, but he has no online modules listed. This is your (his) current certification level. *Note - you may need to enable pop-ups in your browser to do this.*
