# Maplebrook Managers

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- Thank you for volunteering to support your child's team
- Our teams can not function without you!

# Timeline

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- October: Managers Meeting
- October: Annual General Meeting & team meetings
- December 1: Team Budgets complete, teams will not be able to proceed with winter training if a budget has not been turned in.
- December 1: background checks & Code of Conduct completed and turned in
- January-March: Indoor training.
- The MYSA medical forms need to be collected before the first indoor training (just in case something were to happen at training)
- January-April: Tournament registration
- Feb 1st: Player/parent code of conduct and volunteer commitment forms (including volunteerism check deposit). No Pay No Play policy.

# Timeline (con't)

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- March: Team submittals, teams posted on MYSA, District scheduling meetings (preliminary league game schedules), District mandatory coaches meetings (game packet: league game schedule, labels)
- March: Parents must have completed PACT Training
- April: Passes distributed to team managers. Attach photos and sign, laminate passes.
- End of April/Beginning of May: League play begin
- July: End of league play, District playoffs, Regionals & State
- July/August: Finalize summer team budget, Fall soccer registration.

# Website – Team Pages

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- MBSA Coach Yahoo Group-notify club administrator to be added to this e-mail distribution list, [shamamoto@maplebrooksoccer.com](mailto:shamamoto@maplebrooksoccer.com)
- After you have collected all the emails for the families let them know that the team page is the primary tool for communication
- Secure a username and password for your team page on the MapleBrook website.
- List coaches and team manager(s) information.
- List players first or last name (not both first and last names for safety issues) and jersey numbers (optional).
- List game schedule including field locations
- List practice schedule
- It is important to keep the calendar up to date because many families sync this calendar to their personal calendars.

# AGM Team Meeting

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- At this meeting you should have a sample budget for your families
- Have the forms that the families need to complete and return to you: the MYSA Medical Liability/Release form, volunteer commitment form and check, MBSA Player/Parent code of conduct, concussion
- Let parents know about the uniform ordering process.

# Budget

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- The Budgets are due to accountant by December 1, this is mandatory
- Use the team budget form from the website
- The fees you need to calculate include the estimated tournament fees, Additional Indoor Dome Rental / Training, supplies (balls, medical kit, player pass supplies)
- This team fund is the families' money, please provide regular updates to the budget to the families and get family by in on any non-required expenses (parties, coaches gifts, etc..). While you may want to make sure that you have enough money for the tournament, please be respectful of the fact soccer is expensive and we don't want to overburden families.

# Equipment

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- All equipment is paid out of the team fees
- Game ball and four corner flag for home games.
- Pinnies
- Extra balls
- Medical kit
- Cones
- PUGG goals (do not need to be purchased may borrow from club— contact Age Group Coordinator)
- Ice pack- 2 instant ice packs
- 3 ring binder
- Blood Jerseys
- If these can be re-used from prior years, collect what you can from coaches, etc... Otherwise they will need to be purchased by the team fund.

# Player and Coach Passes

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- Collect 1 X 1in photo of every player, coach and manager for pass. Consider taking photos at a practice and print at home
- Susan Hahn-Hamamoto will distribute your passes in the spring
- Get a signature of every player, manager and coach on the back of the pass.
- Laminate each pass the team fund will (office/manager expense) pay for the lamination. 4x6 photos laminate works great - available at Target, Wal-Mart, office supplies. Or clear contact paper.
- Put pass together in alphabetical order (by last names) in a ring.

# Games

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- Game schedule (MYSA) and Field directions (MYSA)
- Rain status info (home games only)
  - Rain Status tab on our website 763-494-5959 after 4:00 PM for an update
- You will be notified as to which district your team will play in.
- There will be a district meeting (“mandatory managers meeting”) to discuss the district rules, and to discuss the team responsibilities and to distribute the schedules.
- Send out game schedule and field locations to players’ families and put on team page
- Reschedule games if necessary. Procedure is given at the mandatory coaches meeting.
- Competitive Match Report filled for every game for all teams.
- Report game score of both home and away games. This is done online on MYSA’s website using username and password given at the mandatory coaches meeting. Your team will be fined by MYSA if this is not done (U11 and older)
- 4 corner flags and a game ball are needed for all home games.

# Home Game Rescheduling

This process is valid only for HOME games. It can also be found on the Team Manager page of the MapleBrook website. For AWAY game reschedules, contact the coach/manager of the other team.

## PROCESS

•MBSA Coach/Manager should determine **three possible dates** with the away team. [Email our Field Coordinator](#), using the template that appears when you click the link.

**Why do I need to get 3 alternate dates?** Multiple alternate dates ensure the field coordinator/referee assignor can place you on a field with referees that are **well qualified** to work your game. With only one date, you could end up with referees that may not be ideally suited to work your rescheduled game. This is particularly important when you are rescheduling a rainout. Remember there could be up to 15 other teams also trying to reschedule from that same night.

**Do we have to play a reschedule on our normal playing night?** No. As long as both teams agree, you can play a reschedule on any night/day of the week. For U11 and up, we recommend you avoid Friday – Sunday...many referees work weekend tournaments (many games in one day) and it can be difficult to find three referees that are available to work one regular season game.

**Can I specify the time we'd like to play?** Sorry, no. There are nearly 60 teams in this club, using 10 fields, not all with lights. The field coordinator/referee assignor needs to find the time that works best for field **AND** referee availability. Considerations will be made only if away teams are travelling from outside of the Twin Cities (example: Duluth, Eau Claire, etc.).

**I know a referee, can we get him/her to work our game?**

No, particularly if they are not already a referee that works with MapleBrook.

# Game Checklist

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- Passes
- Competitive Match Report
- Labeled and stamped envelope (home games)

# Competitive Match Report

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- Fill out rostered players and adults: names, jersey #, id # on player/coach pass. Make copies of this for all games (home & away, tournament).
- Fill out the top portion with District, Team Code, Opponent, Date Played, Master Game # (info found on the game schedule given by MYSA)
- Give this form to the referee before the start of the game.
- For home games, give the referee a stamped, self-addressed label (given at mandatory coaches meeting) envelope
- Referee will fill out the rest of the form and send it in to MYSA
- A game will not start without this

# Tournaments

- Team figures out how many and which tournament to do.
- Use the above link and there is a tool to help you search for tournaments. List is online starting mid January
- Register and pay for tournaments. Pay with credit card, get reimbursed by club is the easiest/fastest.
- Send game schedule and directions for tournament.
- Do tournament check-in for the team.
- Register ASAP because many tournaments fill up fast. The majority of tournaments should be registered for by the end of February.
- One tournament your team will play in is the MapleBrook tournament
- Decide if your team is going to play in post season play if eligible with the team and coach. These tournaments do have additional fees which you should include in your budget if your team is interested in playing. Post Season means regions/districts/state and U11 and up are eligible for this.

# Guest Players

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- Paperwork for guest players are found on MYSA's website.
- Premier players may NOT play on Classic teams for league play.
- Tournament only players may NOT play on Classic teams for league play
- There are specific rules for guest players for League playoffs, Regionals and State (next slide)

# MYSA State Tournament

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- No team U16 through U19 may have more than 22 players listed on the roster and only 18 dressed per match.
- No team U13 through U15 may have more than 18 players listed on the roster
- No more than 14 players listed on a roster for U11 and U12 teams.
- No team may have more than 3 play-ups on the roster for their team.
- No team may cut an available registered player to make room for a play up.
- No team may have players from another team at the same age, gender, and level from within their club.
- No team may have players from another club.
- All rosters are frozen at the League Playoff Tournament.
- No player will be allowed to roster on more than one team during League Playoffs, Regionals or the State Tournament.

# Uniform Kits

This is the first year of a new 2 year Uniform cycle MBSA has chosen to go with a 2 year uniform cycle due to the constraints and limited availability of uniform sizes in the third year of a cycle

- The uniform kit costs \$160 and includes:
  - 2 jerseys (1 red, 1 silver), 1 pair of shorts (red), 2 pair of socks (1 red, 1 silver), Warm-ups pants and Warm Up jacket
  - Women's shorts sizes will be available to order (adult sizes only)
  - Optional adidas Estadio Soccer bag, additional shorts, and socks will also be available to order
  - Online Ordering will be available on the MapleBrook's Website after the AGM
- Oct 30: AGM: Reveal of New Uniform Kit Fitting times and location announced
- Nov 30: Orders due to Planet Soccer (Carol)
  - Orders placed after this date will be assessed a \$15 late fee and cannot be guaranteed.
  - We will continue to take orders for late joining players. The later the order is placed, the later the delivery date.
- Late April: Order Pick Up (Managers)
  - Timing is based on first tournament of the season and we will be sure to distribute to teams in time for early tournaments.
  - If you can't make the dates/times, appoint a parent or coach to come instead. (Please be respectful of Carol's time.)
  - Uniforms must be paid in full before they can be picked up. (For those that are invoiced.)
    - This includes late joining players.

# Uniform FAQ

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- All of the preceding information can be found on the Uniforms & Equipment page on the MBSA website.
  - Carol is committed to keeping the web page updated with the most current information available about uniforms.
- There is also a FAQ document about uniforms posted.
- The web page and the FAQ document answer about 90% of the questions parents & managers have regarding uniforms.
  - PLEASE read it before your team meetings, inform your parents about it and check the web page for updates before you email Carol with your questions.

# Volunteering

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- Team Managers will collect deposit money and Volunteer Commitment Forms
- Coaches, team managers, board members, and all involved in any committees are exempt from the \$100 deposit/ volunteer hrs

U9-U17 Players	Hours	Deposit Amount
1 player	4.0	\$100
2 or more	8.0	\$200

- Families who complete volunteer service by end of summer season ~ deposit check is shredded internally
- Families who have not completed volunteer service by end of season ~deposit check is cashed. Hours do not roll over to the next year.
- Head Coaches will have no additional volunteer hours required. In addition if there is 1 asst coach they also will have no further hours required. If there are 2 asst coaches they will each be required to complete 2 hours of additional volunteering. The same formula goes for managers.

# Honor Roll Achievement Award

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- New name so confusion isn't made with family grant (scholarship)
- Application is on our website
- Players must maintain at least a B Average
- Deadline May 1<sup>st</sup>
- Typically players receive a certificate and a prize
- Distribution by teams at the tournament, or some managers held on to these and distributed at year end celebrations
- Please encourage parents to do this so that their children are not left out of the awards. Also it is the manager who distributes the awards. Please make it a point of having a small ceremony and congratulating the players, this is obviously a very important accomplishment.

- OATHS (Outstanding Ambassadors of Teams Honoring Sportsmanship) is an encouragement education program for traveling Under 9 through Under 19 boys and girls teams that distinguish athletes, coaches and fans for their dedication to good sportsmanship. The goal is to allow the players to enjoy the sporting event as well as the total complement of fans, referees and coaches.
- The OATHS Evaluation is included on every Competitive Match Report. All referees are asked to complete the evaluation of each team's players, coaches and fans. Referees are asked if the players are playing within the rules and spirit of the game. Coaches will be evaluated to make sure all players and officials are treated with respect. And fans are expected to support all players, coaches, and referees in a positive manner.

# OATH con't

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- Responses are tabulated and the data analyzed to determine our OATHS winners. The results of the tabulations are used to evaluate overall sportsmanship throughout the state of Minnesota.
- Teams receiving the highest accumulated marks over the course of the season are presented with recognition pins, special gifts and a certificate of achievement.

# MYSA Medical Insurance

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- Secondary medical insurance or primary medical insurance (if no other medical insurance)
- Insured Persons  
All registered team members, coaches, managers, referees, officials, and volunteers of the teams, leagues or of the association.
- Covered Activities  
Insured persons are covered for injuries (or death) resulting directly and independently of all other causes from accidents occurring while participating in the following covered activities:
  - Scheduled games, team practice sessions or sponsored activities provided they are under the direct supervision of a team official; or sanctioned local or national tournaments as a member of a contestant team.
  - Organized, supervised group travel as authorized by the Policyholder directly to and from a covered event.

# MYSA Medical Insurance con't

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- What Is Not Covered

The plan does not provide coverage for: (1) intentionally self-inflicted injury; (2) air travel except as a fare-paying passenger on a regularly scheduled airline on a scheduled flight; (3) injuries resulting from other than Covered Activities; (4) loss resulting from sickness or disease, except bacterial infection which occurs through an accidental wound.

- Accident Medical Expense Benefits

For reasonable necessary medical expenses, our Youth Soccer Medical Expense Insurance pays up to \$100,000 for injuries sustained in a Covered Accident. Dental injuries are treated like any other injury. Payment will not be made for any expenses incurred after 52 weeks of the accident date. An Expense is considered incurred on the date the Medical Care is rendered. A \$500 Deductible and 80/20 Co-Insurance applies to each covered accident.

- "Injury" means bodily injury of an Insured Person resulting directly and independently of all other causes from an accident which occurs while he or she is participating in a Covered Activity. Sickness or disease (except pus forming infections which occur through an accidental cut or wound) of any kind will not be considered as bodily injury.

- Reasonable Expenses means usual and customary charges.

# Family Grants

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- \$5,000 budgeted
- Up to \$400 per player to help pay for club & team fees
- Completed Applications will be reviewed in December
- Volunteering and a deposit check are required

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- Parents and Coaches Together (PACT) is an educational program developed at the University of Notre Dame's Center for Ethical Education and Development. The program is based on the latest research from developmental and sports psychology and is designed to help coaches and parents to get on the same page in successfully creating a positive and nurturing climate in Minnesota youth soccer.
- MYSA/PACT helps coaches and parents realize their unique roles in fostering athlete intrinsic motivation, developing character, optimal performance, well-being and satisfaction. This program helps develop the potential of youth soccer to all it can, and should be!

# Payment Structure

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- Payment Structure
  - Tryout/Registration Fee (\$60)
    - Paid when registering online
    - Non Refundable
- 2 Invoices will be sent one on 11/15 for club fees and on 1/15 for team fees
  - Families may pay online with a credit card this year
  - If families want to play by check they should pay after each invoice
    - No Pay No Play Policy – Player passes will be held until payments are received in full.
    - Team Budgets need to submitted by Dec 1<sup>st</sup> and a copy needs to go to each family – an email copy is preferred
