LB3 is a year-round club program open to a variety of age and skill levels. Our program is built on the foundations of lacrosse, stressing the fundamentals of the game. As a charter member of the National Scholastic Club Lacrosse Association (NSCLA) we are proud to be identified as one of the top high school and youth club teams in the country. All NSCLA member organizations work to ensure that they are highly competitive by skill, balanced by grade, and organized in such a manner that they provide their athletes the best possible playing and recruiting experience.

While there are many families that have been with us for several years, for 2012 there are also many new faces to our program. I wanted to take a little time to address some of the questions regarding our fee structure and what it encompasses.

Fees required to participate in LB3 Lacrosse are broken down in to two components. Annual Club Dues make up the first part while the second is Tournament Fees. The club dues component for the 2012 season will be \$475 and cover your for both the summer and fall seasons. The tournament Fees vary depending on the team your son will be playing with.

Included in the Club Dues are the following:

1. Uniforms
2. LB3 T-Shirt
3. Coaching Stipends - Each team has one head coach and two college players (normally LB3 Alumni)
4. Field Rentals
5. Equipment (e.g. balls, goals)
6. Insurance
7. Operational Expenses (e.g. technology)
8. Subscription to Inside Lacrosse Magazine

Included in Tournament Fees:

1. Summer Tournament Fees
2. Travel Stipend for coaches
3. Hotel Expenses for coaches

For 2012, our registration on the website is set up to collect both Club Dues and Tournament Fees in one registration session. You will have the ability to opt for either Full Payment or an Installment Plan. We ask that all players register on our website before December 15th.
