

Do I have to pay all of my hockey fees up-front?

No. While the Topeka Youth Hockey Association tries to keep your annual fees as low as possible, we understand that having the fees available up-front isn't possible for everyone. We provide an installment plan, as well as the ability to fundraise these fees.

How does the payment plan work?

If you pay by check you can split your payments up between 4 equal payments. If you register mid-season you can split your payments up into two payments. If your child plays Learn to Play or Atoms payments can be split into equal payments.

Unfortunately, the NGIN website does not allow for us to put partial payments in the system. If you need a balance update, please email Stephanie through the website and she will send you an updated invoice. Fundraising money, including Chuck-a-Puck is only updated once a month.

Please don't ask her at the rink what your balance is, or to send an updated invoice. As you can imagine, with nearly 100 families to keep track of, she probably won't remember who needed the information, and what it was they needed.

What email address does the Treasurer use to send invoices to?

The Treasurer sends invoices out through the website (also referred to as the "NGIN" software). All invoices are sent to the official email account that was used to register the player. If you would like to use a different email address, please change the address by logging into your online account through the website.
