

Wildcat Blue Line Card proposal (open to suggestions and feedback)

All Players would have to purchase a Wildcat Blue Line card starting June 1. Anyone playing hockey would be mandated by the school to have this before they are able to play hockey. Two checks of \$500 would be required one cashed and one not.

The card would solve many problems that the booster club is facing such as money deficit; separation and segregation of people whom finger point for lack of help and work, allow for the ability to make sure families pay the booster club as current we cannot do anything if a person does not pay, as well as establish an early timetable for coaches to see whom might be playing and not to order jerseys, track suits etc..

The first \$500 check would be for our mandatory fundraising events such as Golf tournament, Raffle tickets, and Calendars or Silver saver cards.

All of this money can be collected back if a player sells all of their above materials if you do not you will be out the \$500. Break down of events:

Golf tourney \$250 must do one of the three packages below

A. (4) golf ticket package cost \$260 (65x4) estimated profit \$120 benefit is more golfers at event

B. (2) hole sponsors package cost \$250 max \$200 min, profit \$200 benefit is more profit

C. (2) golf tickets 2 hole sponsors cost \$255 profit \$160 benefit is happy medium

Date of tournament is being worked on, and we are looking to make boys mandatory half the tournament and girls the other half like spaghetti dinner.

Try to have two different flights as one for money players and one for fun. The cash one would be run by the course with 100% payout.

Course would collect Money over and beyond the ticket and cover this end for us. This is being worked on.

Look to have food on course, raffle, and silent auction, entertainment, and cash games

Profit out of gate estimates would be 50 players at approx. \$150 is \$7500

*the food cost is already in this amount *

Raffle

Same as in past, players purchase raffle tickets estimate s 50 players \$100 is \$5000

raffle printing would come out of this

Calendars/Silver Saver

50 at \$150 = \$7500

printing fees would come out of this

\$500 check break down= \$250 golf, \$150 s. saver calendars, \$100 raffle

Total profit estimates=\$20,000 just in mandated revenue sales from the \$500 family mandates

The next \$500 would be held until the end of January when all events are completed to cover Mandated Volunteer hours

Each player will have to work 15 hours then the check will be destroyed or given back. All 15 hours must be worked no prorating
These hours can be used at the following events and subjects and will be tracked and monitored by the chair of the event:

Golf tournament (over and beyond your package mandates and the players must work day of event)
Beer Wine tasting
Spaghetti Diner
Game day sponsors/programs
Calendars/silver saver cards
Other board approved events

Generating 50 kids at 15 hours would get us a minimum of 750 hours of work. People whom do not want to help can just pay the \$500
