

Fishers - HSE Youth Baseball Amendments for USSSA Rules

February 5, 2010

- 2.02: If a USSSA sanctioned official is not available a non-USSSA official may be used.
2.03: Does not apply for 2010 season.
2.04: Does not apply for 2010 season.
4.10.A: If all tied teams have not played head to head, 4.10.B will be used.
5.14.A: If all tied teams have not played head to head, 5.14.B will be used.
6.13.A: If all tied teams have not played head to head, 6.13.B will be used.
8.04.S: If a team forfeits a game each and every player on that teams tournament roster is assessed 3 innings pitched (at the time and day of the forfeited game).
8.09.F Outfield players must be positioned in the grass of the outfield.
8.09.H One defensive coach is allowed in the field (positioned in the outfield) of play to help provide instruction to the outfield.
9.01 If a USSSA sanctioned official is not available a non USSSA official may be used.
12.01 If a coach is ejected he will sit out that game and the next game.
12.02 A player ejected from a game will sit in the dugout the remainder of that game. He will also sit out the next game.
12.03 A coach ejected from a game must leave the park for the balance of that game and must not be in the park for the next game.

For the Midwest Baseball Championships, Tri-State Invitational and the Rec-All Star State Championships, the following pitching limitations shall be used.

- 8.05.C.1 Column A: The maximum number of innings a player can pitch in one day and not be required one days rest. Any inning count over 3 innings (Ages 7-12) or 4 innings (Ages 13-14) in one day will require a day of rest the following day.
8.05.C.2 Column B: The maximum number of innings a player can pitch in one day.
8.05.C.1 Column C: The maximum number of innings a player can pitch in the tournament.
- Rule 8.08.G.2 Comment: For age divisions 7U – 12U, this is to be interpreted as a player can pitch any combination of innings that equals eleven (11) as long as he doesn't pitch more than six (6) innings in any one day pursuant to Rule 8.08.G.2.
Rule 8.08.G.2 Comment: For age divisions 13U – 14U, this is to be interpreted as a player can pitch any combination of innings that equals thirteen (13) as long as he doesn't pitch more than seven (7) innings in any one day pursuant to Rule 8.08.G.2.
