JUNIOR VARSITY UPDATE

Through the first six games of the season, the Red Knights have posted a 5-1-0 record ... The line of Storm Sullivan, Tanner Ahlborn and Zach Gionet has combined for 17 goals and 40 points thus far ... Sullivan has 10 goals, including a four-goal outing in a 6-1 win over Marshall ... Ahlborn and Gionet share the team lead with nine assists apiece ... Jack Lawton's +16 rating is tied with Sullivan and Ahlborn for the team lead ... Chris Hickok leads the team's defensemen with two goals and eight points ... All 15 skaters have recorded points for BSM and 13 of those 15 have scored goals ... The Red Knights have recorded more short-handed shots (20) than power-play shots (17) ... The Red Knights are averaging 39.0 shots on goal per game ... Will Jarvis has won all three of his starts, posting a 1.41 goals against average and a .907 save percentage to go with his 3-0-0 record.



Red Knight Game Night

Good evening ladies and gentlemen and welcome to the St. Louis Park Recreation Center. Tonight, the sixth-ranked Red Knights play host to third-ranked Maple Grove in the final pre-Christmas game of the year for both teams.

These two teams met for the first time a year ago with BSM claiming a 4-3 win as Grant Besse scored twice in the third period as the Red Knights overcame a 3-2 deficit.

This season, BSM has got off to a 5-1-0 start and was won its last three games by a 26-6 margin over three ranked opponents, claiming a 5-2 win over Marshall (#6A), a 15-2 win over Holy Angels (#20AA) and a 6-2 North Suburban Conference victory over Totino-Grace (#8A).

Christian Horn became the school's all-time assist in the win over Holy Angels, as the first of his seven assists on the night was the 88th of his career, surpassing Chris Student to establish a new school mark.

Scoring has been in great supply for the Red Knights to date, as they have tallied 46 goals in six games, averaging 7.67 goals per game with six players recording four or more goals and eight players averaging at least a point per game.

BSM has gotten four hat tricks on the season thus far. Grant Besse notched the ninth of his career in the season opener while T.J. Moore has collected the first two of his career and Jake O'Borsky collected three goals and his second five-point night of the season in the win over Holy Angels.

BSM has been solid in its own zone as well, allowing just 2.17 goals per game and 19.3 shots per game.

The Crimson have started off the season with a 6-0-1 record, including an impressive 3-0 victory Edina in the second game of the season.

The only blemish on Maple Grove's record is a season-opening 3-3 tie at Wayzata. Since then, the Crimson have rattled off six consecutive wins to earn their number-three ranking.

Special teams have been one reason for Maple Grove's success as the Crimson are 8-for-24 (.333) on the power play while killing penalties at a .871 clip (27-for-31).

Heading into it's nine-day break, the Red Knights would like to wish everyone a Merry Christmas and a happy holiday season.
