Purpose of Fund: This scholarship is intended to give financial assistance to deserving participants of the GVHA Midget & U19 youth hockey programs (herein after and collectively referred to as “Participant” for assistance in their pursuit of higher education.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Participant must be a graduating senior in high school, a current member of the GVHA Midget or U19 youth hockey programs and enrolled in a University, College, Technical Institution or Jr. College in the United States no later than the fall after graduation from High School.
- Participant must be a graduating member of the GVHA Midget or U19 hockey teams.

Awards:

- This is a \$300.00 one-time scholarship payable to one Midget and one U19 youth hockey participant.
- The award is made payable to the educational institution on behalf of the student and will be mailed to the institution by GVHA.
- This award is non-renewable and is for the first semester of undergraduate study only. It is to be applied to tuition, books, supplies, fees, and on campus room and board only. If

the student fails to enroll in a semester or trimester within the first year of undergraduate study that portion of the scholarship will be forfeited.

- Participant will be required to provide all requested information.

Winner Selection:

- Selection of recipient is based on a combination of GVHA participation and extracurricular activities. Participant must submit a written essay outlining their career goals including why Participant is applying for this scholarship.
- Selection will be non-discriminatory, without regard to gender, race, color, creed, religious beliefs, or financial need.

The following applications must be completed as well as the above requirements.

1. The student must complete and return the entire application to GVHA at the address listed above.
2. Utilizing the Application and the information supplied, the Scholarship Advisory Committee evaluates each application based on specific criteria for the fund.
3. Based on the Scholarship Advisory Committee evaluation, the applicant may be awarded a scholarship to be applied to tuition or for other approved purposes.
4. The scholarships will be awarded annually at local graduation ceremonies or by mail.
5. The GVHA Scholarship Fund Advisory Committee will never sell or provide ANY information to list companies or other organizations. We consider your information to be confidential and we will keep all submitted information private. Except for purposes of granting scholarships or other awards, any information submitted by applicants will never leave the possession of the GVHA Scholarship Fund Advisory Committee.
