



Anaheim Pony Baseball Team Parent Code of Conduct

Team Parents are expected to adhere to the following Code of Conduct and to recognize that they are role models and examples to all players and parents and will conduct themselves accordingly.

No Team parent shall at any time, from any place, use signs, gestures, degrading personal comments or perform any unsportsmanlike acts which in any manner refers to, or reflects upon, opposing players, umpires, managers, spectators or any fellow team parent.

All team parents will:

1. Maintain a level of confidentiality with players information
2. Ensure the participation of parents in all league functions.
3. Be financially responsible for all monies collected on behalf of Anaheim Pony Baseball.
4. Provide a receipt for all monies collected (a receipt book will be provided to you by the league).
5. Be responsible for turning in monies to the league or Team Parent Coordinator in the form of a cashier's check or money order only. **NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
6. Provide any financial records to any member of their team upon request
7. Provide any financial records to APB at any given time for purposes of an audit.
8. Maintain a running ledger on all monies collected, paid out or turned in to the league or Team Parent Coordinator. (A ledger will be provided to you as a hard copy as well as emailed to you by the league.)
 - a. This will prepare you for a league audit at any time.
9. All ledgers are to be turned in to Anaheim Pony Baseball prior to Closing Day Ceremonies.

Team Parents who do not adhere to the above will be subject to disciplinary action as stated in the Anaheim Pony Baseball standing rules under Article IX: APB Rules of Conduct- B: Disciplinary Action.
