



CHECK-IN & GAME INFORMATION

Check-in Time and Location:

- **Thursday 1/26 – 5:30pm to 9pm - Fairfield Inn, 5909 Stone Creek Drive, The Colony, 75056**
- **Friday 1/27 – 5pm to 9pm**
 - **If playing Friday at Good – check in at Good**
 - **All other teams check in at 5 Star**
- **Saturday 1/28 – ONLY FOR OUT OF TOWN TEAMS** – check in where your first game will be played

Make sure to check-in at least 1 hour before your game. Games will not be delayed because of check-in.

COMPETITIVE TEAMS (U11 – U16)

- Tournament Check- In List
- Official Spring Team Roster - signed by registrar and coach
- Original Guest Player Release (max 5)
 - Tournament keeps the original; make sure you have a copy for your records
 - Properly executed form – all signatures and State Association assigned registration number – required in order to play
- Medical Release for each player on your roster and for each guest player
 - Will be required to show at check-in
 - Preferred notarized, however not required
- Game Roster & Misconduct Report (5 copies)
 - COMPLETED with roster and game information
 - Tournament retains one completed form with roster information
 - Game Reports will be stamped at check-in
- Travel Teams – outside NTX jurisdiction
 - Signed USYS Travel Authorization
 - Signed Travel ID cards (player, coaches, and managers)

ACADEMY TEAMS (U7 – U10)

- NTX Academy Tournament Roster (not your regular league roster) – must be signed by association registrar
 - You are allowed to use an Academy Tournament Roster from another tournament within the 2011-2012 soccer year
 - Only those players on the roster are eligible to play in this tournament
 - U7/U8 will play 8 v 8 – max roster size is 14
 - U9 will play 9 v 9 – max roster size is 16
 - U10 will play 11 v 11 – max roster size is 18
 - You will be required to show your Academy Player Registration Form for each player listed on the Academy Tournament Roster
 - **No guest players allowed for Academy teams**
- Medical Release is included on the PAL Form
- Game Roster & Misconduct Report (5 copies)
 - COMPLETED with roster and game information
 - Tournament retains one completed form with roster information
 - Game Reports will be stamped at check-in

Tournament Weather Information:

All updates for weather will be posted to the tournament page on the website and via SMS TXT service you can sign up for on the tournament page.

Game Times

- Friday games times are 6pm, 7:15pm and 8:30pm
- Saturday and Sunday games run in 1.5 hour increments starting at 8:am with last start at 8pm
- Every attempt will be made for at least 2 game slots between the games you play

Game Locations:

Distance between the complexes is approximately 11 miles; average travel time 15 mins via highway

5 Star Complex – 4100 Blair Oaks, The Colony, TX. Located a block north of the intersection of Memorial Drive and Blair Oaks.

R.E. Good – 2355 Sandy Lake Road, Carrollton, TX. Approximately 1 mile west of I35E

Good Fields located behind McKinnish fields past the baseball fields. There is no access from Belt Line Road.

Medical Trainers

For injured players or spectators, there will be trainers available at each location near the concession stand

Game Procedures

1. Each team provides the center referee with a stamped Game Report at the beginning of each game
2. After the game, the center referee will record the score, enter yellow and red card information, sign the report
3. It is your responsibility to get the game report from the referee after the game and check it for accuracy
4. Each team must turn a signed game report into Tournament Headquarters for official posting of the game score - each location will have a headquarter setup
5. Sit-Out Verification Forms if required must be signed by the referee and returned to Tournament Headquarters
