**Directions to Sinclair Sinclair Secondary School:** Take Hwy. 401 to the Brock Street exit (Whitby), go North to Taunton Rd.(approx 8 - 10 minute drive), turn Right. School is located on the North side of Taunton; enter building on the North-east side near the portables.

**Expectations of the Participant:**

- This is a **2 day clinic, spread over two weekends**
- Please dress appropriately for activity, bring a stick & ball plus clipboard & pen.
- Pre-clinic assignment as noted on the OWL website.
- When you arrive at the clinic you are expected to submit one lacrosse drill in writing. It can be a warm up activity, skill drill, modified game or conditioning activity.
- Coaches are expected to be active during discussions and share coaching information and experiences during this clinic.
- Upon completion of coaching season, you are expected to submit the evaluation workbook.

**NOTE:** As the NCCP moves through the transition, from Levels to Competency Based certification, coaches need to become familiar with the new terminology. By attending this clinic you will be considered “trained.”

**All coaches must be “evaluated”, which means they have attended clinic and complete the Video element of the post evaluation along with the evaluation workbook.**

**You will receive an email once your application has been accepted.**
