

## MINNESOTA SWARM'S FINAL 2012 REGULAR SEASON GAME WILL AIR LIVE ON CBS SPORTS NETWORK

The Swarm's April 28th contest against Colorado has been moved up to a 6:30 p.m. CT start time

SAINT PAUL, Minn. – The National Lacrosse League's (NLL) Minnesota Swarm announced today that its final 2012 regular season game against the Colorado Mammoth on Saturday, April 28 from Treasure Island Field at Xcel Energy Center will air live on CBS Sports Network. To accommodate a national television audience, the game's start time has been moved up to 6:30 p.m. CT. The game will also air in High Definition.

"The Swarm is excited to host another nationally televised game this year," Swarm Owner and President John Arlotta said. "This game is not only a great opportunity to showcase our team on national television, but it also gives lacrosse fans and players a chance to come out to the game and show how big the sport of lacrosse has become in the state of Minnesota."

Swarm Co-Owner and Vice President Andy Arlotta, who also sits on the league's Properties Committee, added, "We're very excited that CBS Sports Network has added professional box lacrosse to its lineup. What's even more exciting for Swarm fans is that for the second year in a row, we will have a live, nationally televised game. For our organization to be sought after as one of the league's live games is a testament to our strong fan base. We look forward to once again exposing Swarm lacrosse to the rest of the country."

Earlier this year, the NLL reached a two-year agreement with CBS Sports Network to air NLL games during the 2012 and 2013 seasons. The Minnesota Swarm begins its eighth season of play in the NLL on Saturday, Jan. 14 on the road against the Colorado Mammoth at 8 p.m. CT. The Swarm will host the Buffalo Bandits on Treasure Island Field at Xcel Energy Center for its home opener on Saturday, Jan. 28 at 7 p.m. CT.
