

Stallions 2012 Parent/Player Code of Conduct

AS A PARENT OF A STALLIONS PARTICIPANT, IT'S IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU UNDERSTAND AND ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING

- All players, parents, and fans are to adhere to the rules and regulations of the Homer Township Sports Complex in regards to traffic, field usage, parking, and alcohol/tobacco usage. This also applies to other Parks and Facilities that we visit while on the road.
- Due to insurance and regulations and for safety purposes, no one except the players, coaches, board members, and other board approved individuals will be allowed in the roped off sidelines.
- Parents are not allowed on the sidelines with players and coaches at anytime during the game.
- Parents interfering with practice will be asked to leave the Sports Complex.
- Parents and visitors are to park in the designated parking spots only or as directed by a Homer Board Member/Volunteer.
- Parents are responsible for making sure that their child is on-time for practices/games and that they are picked up on time following Stallions events.
- All players, fans, and coaches are to use good sportsmanship and conduct.
- If any issues arise during the year that can not be worked out privately with the coach or appropriate Board Member (Athletic Director, Cheer Director, Flag Director), the issue should be immediately brought to the attention of the Grievance Committee. The Grievance Committee process is identified on the Stallions website. The Grievance Committee will review the complaint and determine the best course of action.
- The Stallions provide the rules and policies of the organization in the handbook on the Stallions website and is available to be downloaded and printed for football players and all cheerleaders. It is the parent's responsibility to read and be familiar with this information as it can change from year to year.
- Parents are reminded that schedule changes can occur. The Stallions attempt to give as much notice as possible, but sometimes unforeseen circumstances arise. Parents and players need to be flexible to these schedule changes during the season.

Failure to adhere to the above could result in disciplinary action. All violations of this code will be documented.
