

Camp Staff

It hasn't taken long for Susie Johnson to settle into her role as the head coach for the UWM volleyball program.

Johnson was named head coach in May of 2007 after 10 years as an assistant and associate head coach in Milwaukee. All she has done since is lead UWM to 110 wins, four regular season titles, three league tournament crowns and three NCAA Tournament berths.



This past season could well be her best. The Panthers went 25-5 overall and UWM went 16-0 in league play, becoming the first Horizon League team to go through the league schedule without a loss since Notre Dame did it in 1994. Milwaukee also set a school-record with 18-straight wins and nearly upset Iowa State in the first round of the postseason.



UWM has won either the regular season or tournament championship in league play in all 15 seasons Johnson has been on the staff at UWM, while nine of the last 15 Panther squads have qualified for the NCAA Tournament. In fact, UWM has staked its claim to clearly being the top volleyball program in the Horizon League. The Panthers have won a league-record six league tournament titles while Milwaukee has gone 200-50 in Horizon League play since joining the conference (then the MCC) in 1994. UWM's .800 league winning percentage is easily the league's best.

In her 15 seasons in Milwaukee, UWM has compiled a 336-111 record. That number includes a 187-25 mark in league play and a 156-26 record at home. Plus, the Panthers have won 98 of their 105 home league matches with Johnson on the bench.

Johnson is joined by assistant coach Lindsey Vanden Berg. She is a former Panther standout who earned All-America honors during her senior season.

Cost • \$115 commuter/\$215 resident*
*** - Entire team must register as residents**

This camp will provide teams an opportunity to play against some of the best competition in the state. The camp is open to 24 teams with a minimum of eight players per team.

Note to coaches and campers: Your high school coach is encouraged to use three of the "unrestricted coaching opportunities" for this tournament camp. If your high school coach is not available, you can have another representative lead your team or you can coach your own team. UWM camp counselors will be floating and giving periodic instruction, but will not be assigned to a specific team.

Camp Information

• OBJECTIVE/CAMPER-TO-COACH RATIO

Our objective is to improve the skill level of every camper and to give everyone a better understanding of the game of volleyball. Our camp staff will provide an atmosphere to make learning fun and challenging at the same time. There will be one coach for every 12-14 campers for the youth and individual camps.

• FACILITIES

Panther Volleyball Camps are held in the Klotsche Center, the home of Panther volleyball.

• COSTS/MEALS

Registration fees for each camper include instruction, camp t-shirt, individual attention, team exercises, awards and lunch. The youth camp is \$220, the individual camp is \$200 and the tournament camp is \$115 per player (\$215 for resident campers).

• EQUIPMENT

Each camper should dress appropriately in workout clothing. Campers may want to bring an extra t-shirt on hot days, though the Klotsche Center is air-conditioned. Volleyball/cross-training shoes and kneepads are also recommended.

• INSURANCE/MEDICAL FORMS

Campers MUST have their own health insurance, and each camper must complete and return medical history and medical release forms to participate. WE CANNOT PERMIT THE CAMPER TO BE A PART OF CAMP UNLESS THESE FORMS ARE RETURNED. You will receive medical forms in the mail with your confirmation or you can download them from our website at www.uwmpanthers.com (visit the Fan Zone and click on camps) and return with your registration.

• DEADLINES/REFUNDS/CANCELLATIONS

The deadline for each camp is 10 days prior to the first session and all payments are to be made in full. Late registrations will be accepted but are subject to an additional \$50 fee. No refunds will be given for non-medical reasons once the applicant has been accepted. Medical excuses must be presented with an authorized doctor's notice. In case of unforeseen circumstances, in which a camp is cancelled, the camp office will notify you two weeks prior to the start of camp. A full refund will be processed.

• CONFIRMATION

A confirmation letter will be e-mailed (mailed for those without e-mail addresses) approximately three weeks prior to the start of all camps (team camp confirmations will be done through the high school coach/contact only). If you are registering after that time and are seeking confirmation, call the camp office at 866-896-CAMP.

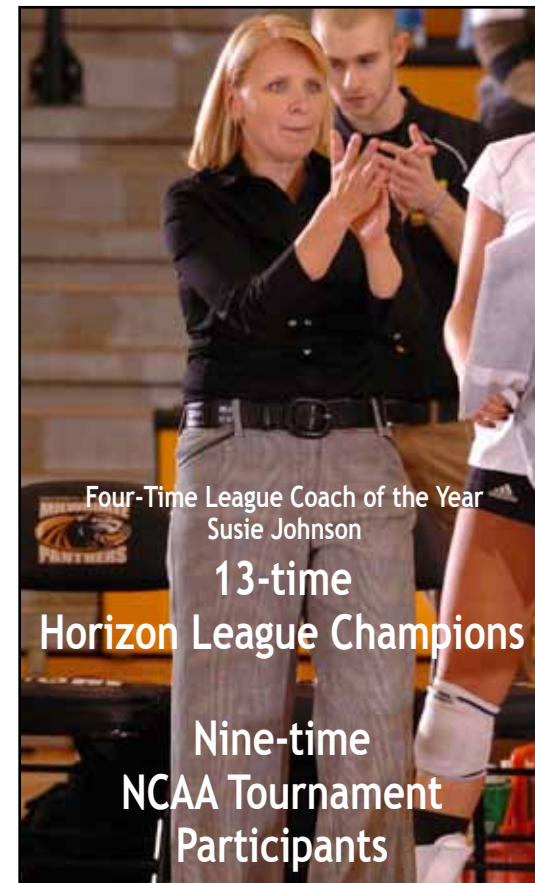
