**PYA HALL OF FAME**

**ELLIOT LEVINE**



Elliot Levine's induction into the Hall of Fame celebrates a legacy of giving that will benefit the children of Port Washington for years to come. PYA's explosive growth and development during the past decade is due in no small part to Elliot's invaluable contributions as a coach, commissioner, director and fundraiser.

Elliot served as a PYA basketball coach and commissioner for nearly a decade while also coaching baseball during that same time period. In 1995, Elliot was elected to the PYA Board of Directors where he was a long-standing member of the Board's Fundraising, Disciplinary and Finance Committees. In over a

dozen years on the Board, Elliot was a tireless advocate and fundraiser for PYA. The Levine-Kaufman Fieldhouse at Lion's Field is named in honor of Elliot's father, Walter Levine, and his wife Cheryl's father, Jack Kaufman. The Fieldhouse is now the central location for virtually all of PYA administrative activities. In addition, Elliot has funded a scholarship at Schreiber High School for graduating seniors who are "PYA Alumni" in honor of his father.

Elliot was raised in Flushing, Queens and graduated from the City University of New York with a degree in Accounting. At CUNY, Elliot was on the varsity swimming and water polo teams for four years and was captain of the school's water polo team. In high school, Elliot played varsity baseball for three years and was an all county swimmer for two years. In addition to his work with PYA, Elliot has been a member of the Gyrodyne Corporation Board of Directors since 2003 and was a member of the Port Washington Soccer Club's Board from 1995-2000.

Elliot is a partner in the accounting firm of Levine & Seltzer LLP in New York (specializing in tax and consulting work). He and his wife Cheryl have lived in Port Washington since 1983 where they raised their two sons Jarryd and Zachary. Both of his sons were active in PYA, playing both baseball and basketball. The Board of Directors thanks Elliot for his years of tireless service and honors him as its newest member of the PYA Hall of Fame.
