



## Field Monitor – Job Description

### Job Description

- Arrive 15 minutes before start time
- Monitor game/field activity
- Sit at score table and perform score table operations
- Check team rosters and coaches' badges
- Keep games on time
- Submit report of each game – online form
- Wear IMLAX FIELD MONITOR identifier
- Remain at the field for the assigned times. This will vary from 2-6 hours per game day.
- Serve as an on-field contact for emergency situations

The individual is there to serve as the “eyes and ears” of the league. You are there to keep things moving and report. You are NOT there to police anyone or get involved in the game. You are NOT to engage in an incident but rather just monitor and report. This will include:

- report negative or positive coach/fan/player behavior
- fan/coach/official/player incident reporting
- concussion documentation
- review of game officials
- player/coach ejections

### Job Requirements

- Individual must be at least 16 years old
- Individual must have access to smart phone
- Individual must have access to reliable transportation
- Individual will be an independent contractor (IRS form 1099, each individual will need to fill out and submit a W-9 prior to receiving first check)
- Individual recommended to bring a chair and/or shade canopy.
- Individual must be dressed and prepared for any and all weather. Lightning is the only weather that cancels games.
- Individual must be available to work a portion of the following dates:  
March 25      April 29                      May 18 (Thurs. evening)  
April 1        May 4 (Thurs. evening)      May 20  
April 8        May 6  
April 15      May 11 (Thurs. evening)  
April 22      May 13
- Hours will vary. Hours will generally be between 9 AM-4 PM on Saturdays and 5 PM-8PM on Thursdays. You may not receive hours on every game day.
- Option to work playoff week will be given to high performing individuals. May 22-26.

### Compensation

- Individual will receive \$10 per game
- Pay checks will be sent April 17, May 1, May 15, and May 30
