

# Who is a Salt Creek Rural Park District resident?

If your place of residence falls within Park Boundaries, a portion of your (or your landlord's) real estate taxes goes to that park district. In exchange, you may receive a discounted price for Park District programs or use of facilities.

If you reside in an unincorporated area and pay no Park District taxes, you are considered a non-resident at all Park Districts. Your tax bill and your voter's registration card indicate which, if any, park district receives tax dollars from you.

The Salt Creek Park District encompasses the southeast corner of Palatine, a north central portion of Rolling Meadows and a small section in west central Arlington Heights. Please refer to the map on page 43 of this brochure.




# Northwest Special Recreation Association

#### **Park Policies**

#### **Playground Safety**

A reminder to all parents: All Salt Creek Rural Park District playground areas are unsupervised. We hope that you and your children enjoy your play experience using the Salt Creek Rural Park District's parks.

#### Roller Blades/Scooters/Skateboards

Roller blades, skateboards and scooters are allowed on paved areas only. No rollerblades, skateboards or scooters are allowed on park district tennis courts, the wooden deck at Twin Lakes or in the nature areas.

#### **Dog Ordinance**

The Salt Creek Park District enforces the following rules in regards to dogs in the parks:

- Dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6 ft. and under control at all times.
- Owners are responsible for removal and sanitary disposal of any excrement deposited by the animal on park property.
- Due to Public Health Rules, only service animals are allowed on patio areas around the Twin Lakes Recreation Area clubhouse, deck or tent.



- During special events, only service animals will be allowed in the areas where food is served or consumed.
- No dogs allowed in the water.
- No dogs allowed in or around the playground

#### **Drone Policy**

The Salt Creek Park District recognizes the popularity of unmanned aircrafts or drones and the need for large open spaces for the operation of these devices. However, the park district has to be cognizant of the safety and privacy concerns of our residents.

# FACILITY RENTALS

#### **PAVILION RENTALS**

#### Rose Park, Grealish Park and South Park

Reservations and a rental fee are required to secure usage of any of the Park District's picnic pavilions. Pavilions are available for rent at the following parks: Patrick T. Grealish Park, South Park, and Rose Park. A maximum of 40 people throughout the rental time is allowed.

Fees are non-refundable once an application is processed. If a rental request is made two weeks prior to the rental date, only cash or charge will be accepted. NO LIQUOR is allowed in the park. Tents or volleyball nets cannot be erected anywhere in the park(s). Carnival games or inflatables are not allowed. Pavilion rentals are taken at Rose Park, 530 S. Williams Avenue. Renter must be present at all times during the rental or you will lose your deposit. Please refer to the application for Park Regulations.

Residents may reserve any pavilion over the phone for the 2018 season beginning on January 2. Non-residents may reserve a pavilion beginning February. A credit card number will be held for the deposit. It will only be charged if a violation of the rental agreement occurs.

- 1. Each person on the course must have a paid receipt.
- 2. No walkers (or caddies) allowed on the course.
- 3. Each person on the course must have their own set of clubs and bag. Club sharing is not allowed.
- 4. Children ages 11 and under must play with an adult.
- 5. Slower players, or players looking for lost balls, must allow those following to play through.
- 6. Shirt and appropriate shoes must be worn on course. No metal spikes.
- 7. Players must use a tee for all tee shots.
- 8. Foursomes will be required when play is heavy.
- 9. No rain checks issued after third hole or during twilight
- 10. Players must seek shelter when the Thor Guard lightning safety horn is sounded. Round may be resumed after all clear signal is given.
- 11. Golfers are liable for damage to surrounding property or injury to other golfers.
- 12. On the 1st and 2nd tee, after 2 balls in water, players must play ball from drop area.
- 13. Players are not permitted to play more than one golf ball during a round.
- 14. No outside alcohol may be brought into park or taken on golf course.
- 15. Please keep pull carts off the greens and aprons.
- 16. Keep gas carts off greens and tee boxes. Drivers must be at least 19 years old.
- 17. The Park District reserves the right to close the course for any general safety concerns to the patrons of Twin Lakes.
- 18. The Park District may establish other rules and procedures deemed necessary for the operation of the facility.

# OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES

#### Ice Skating

The Park District provides unsupervised lake ice skating on the east lake (Donut Lake) at the Twin Lakes Recreation Area (no skating is allowed on the west lake of the Twin Lakes Recreation Area). Skating will commence when the thickness of the lake ice reaches 7" throughout the lake. At that time, the red warning flags at the boathouse and the fishing piers will be changed to green and the lake will be open for skating. The lake will remain open until the ice deteriorates below 7" or the ice becomes soft and unstable. The Park District will also close the lake at any time if it deems any ice conditions unsafe. Please do not skate outside the roped off area.

### Ice Fishing & Safety Information

The Park District provides ice fishing on the east lake (Donut Lake) at the Twin Lakes Recreation Area (no ice fishing is allowed on the west lake of the Twin Lakes Recreation Area). All ice fishermen should stop at the Twin Lakes Clubhouse and purchase a daily fishing pass before proceeding onto the lake. Fishing is only allowed in designated areas. No fishing will be allowed in the roped off areas of the ice skating rinks. All conditions for ice fishing (opening and closing of the lake for fishing) are the same as lake skating.

#### Green Flag Flying

Ice has reached 7" throughout the lake, skating and fishing is permitted.

# Red Flag Flying

Ice has NOT reached a safe thickness, skating and fishing prohibited.

# Fishing Catch and Release

Donut Lake has been stocked with a number of different breeds of fish. The park district has a "catch and release" rule on the TIGER MUSKIES AND NORTHERN PIKE in the lake. Thank you for your cooperation. If you have any questions on this rule, please ask. Flyers on types of fish are available at the clubhouse.


