

Parental Expectations

Playing Time

The organization assumes that the young man will be a good player with quality instruction. Nobody at the youth level knows who will be the cream of the crop at 18 or 19 years old. Some players mature at 11 or 12 years old, however, most players have had limited opportunities to grow as players and this assumption allows for players to develop regardless of their current skill level or stature. Some players are behind the curve and the only way to get better is to practice and play the game.

In tournament play we are committed to placing our top players on the field to demonstrate they have earned and proven they have the right to be in the starting nine. This method allows for young and inexperienced players the time to hone their skills, while maintaining a realistic and competitive atmosphere.
